

## ScreenWise Program Update: April 2017

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### CLAIMS AND BILLING UPDATE

1. **2017 Reimbursement Schedule** – Is now available on the [ScreenWise website](#), this reimbursement list is effective 5/1/2017 through 1/31/2018.
  2. **Reminder** – Please submit enrollment forms for patients within 5 days. ScreenWise is often billed by Ancillary Providers before receiving an Enrollment form, causing patient claims to deny and patients to be billed. Getting the Enrollment form in right away will help prevent this problem.
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### PROGRAM UPDATE

1. **Now Available: ScreenWise Eligibility Checklist with updated Federal Poverty Level (FPL) Guidelines** – The ScreenWise Eligibility Checklist’s FPL chart was updated Effective 5/1/2017. The FPL chart is available to help providers and patients determine if patients meet income eligibility for ScreenWise (250% FPL). Please note that patients self-declare their eligibility, meaning they do not need proof or documentation in order to qualify. The Eligibility Checklist is available on the ScreenWise [website](#).
