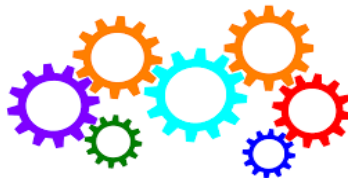

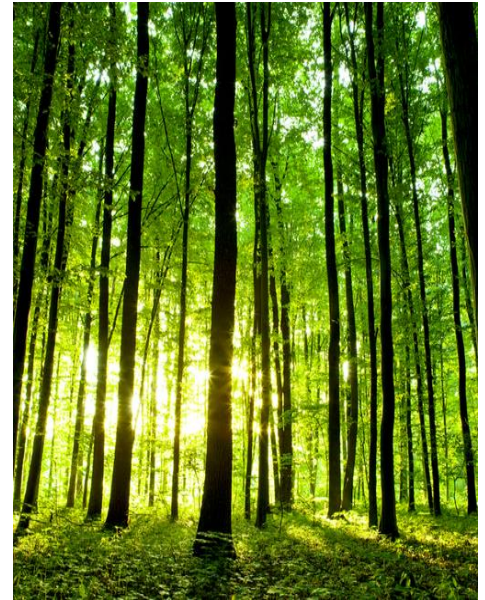

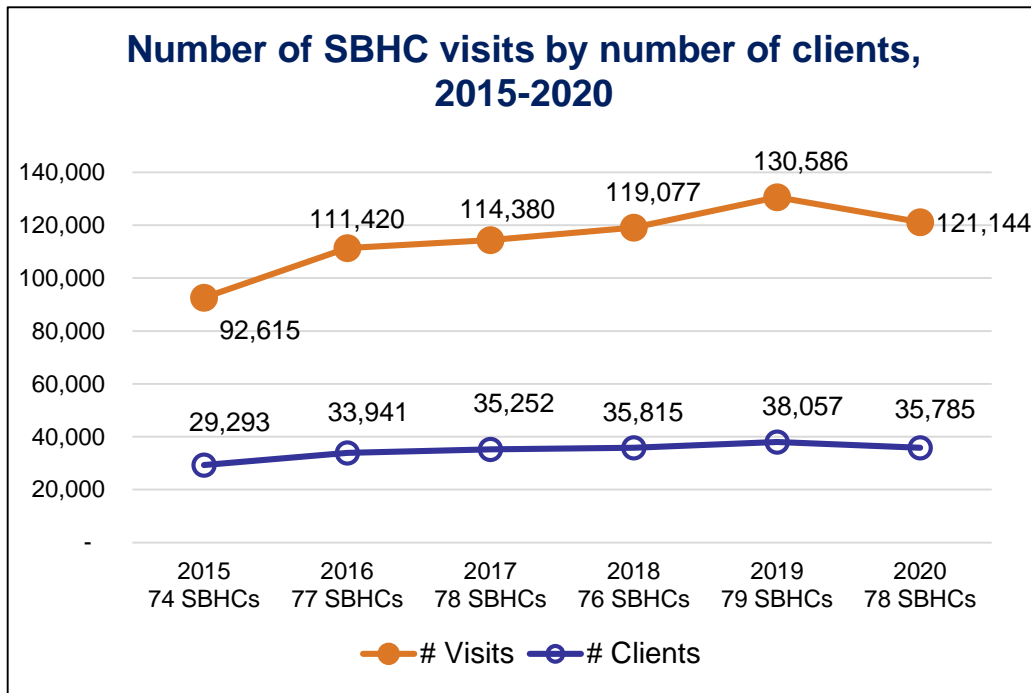
Data and reporting

Trends in SBHC Utilization: 2015 - 2020

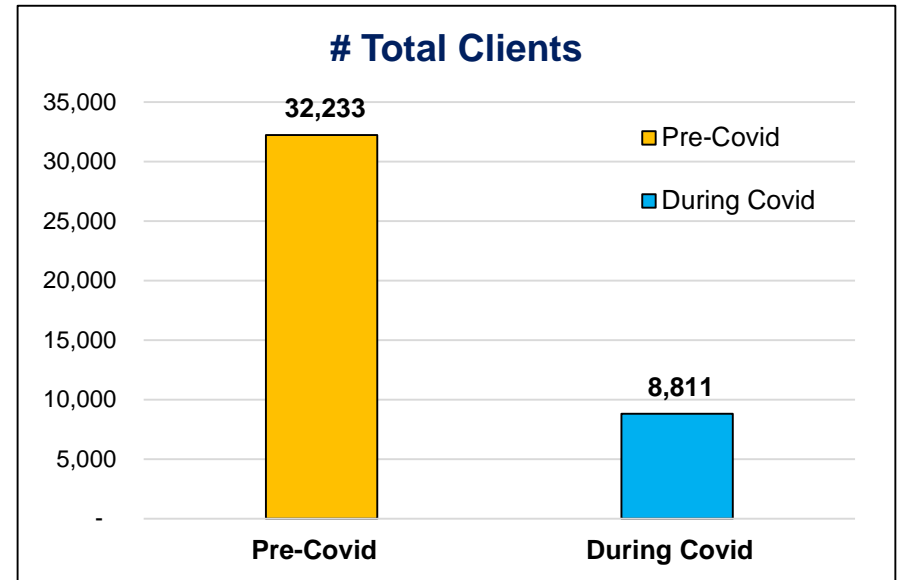
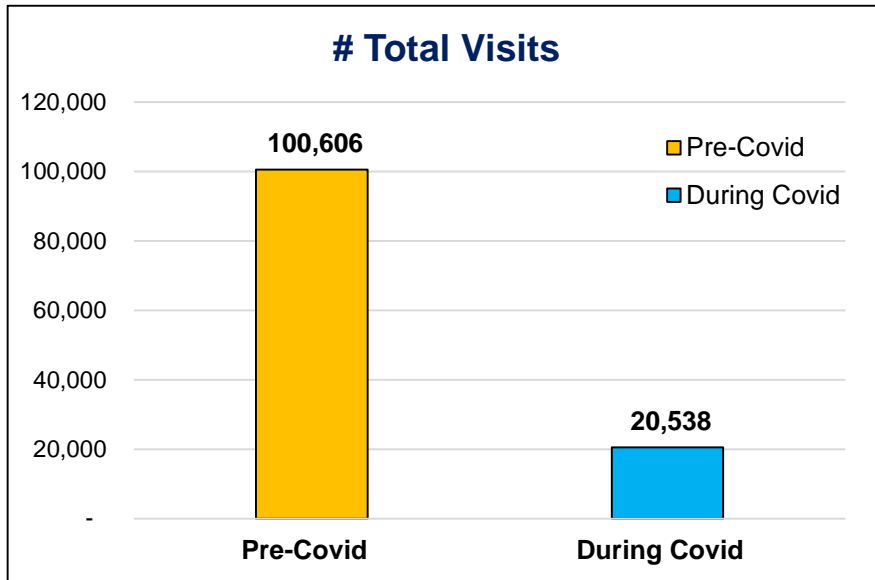


- As of July 1, 2020, Oregon has 78 certified SBHCs in 25 counties
- During SY 2019-20 (7/1/2019 – 6/30/2020) Oregon SBHCs provided 121,144 visits for 35,785 clients

- 34% of clients received an immunization
- 37% of all SBHC visits were to see a behavioral health professional
- 11 SBHCs had a dental provider

#Total Visits & Clients

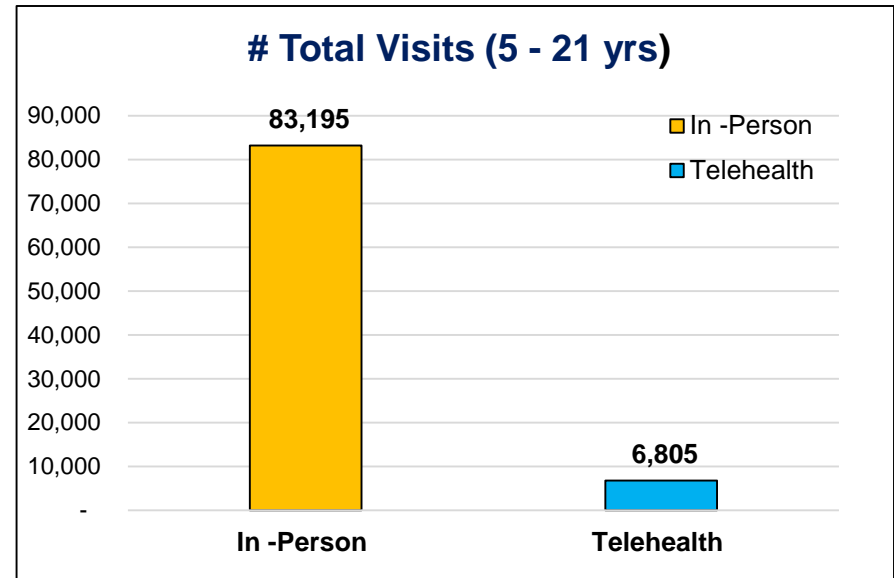
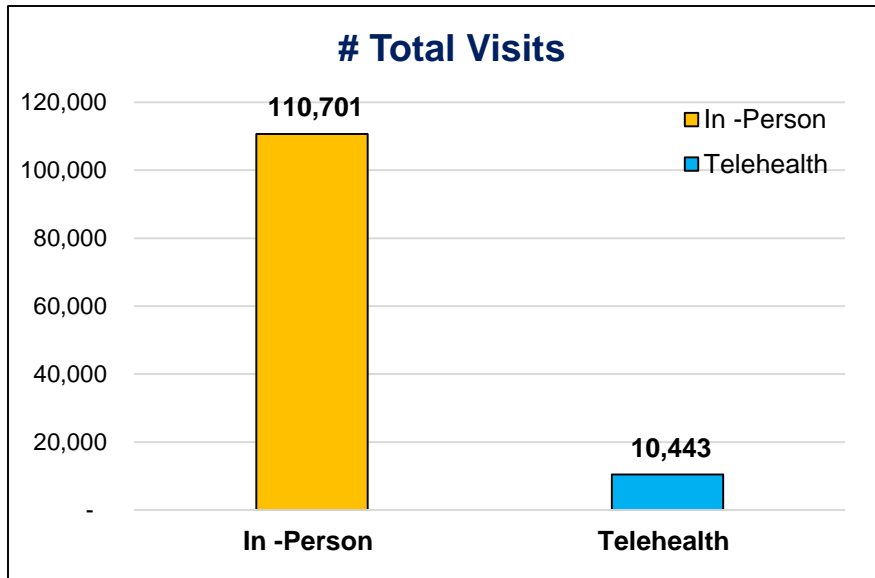
Pre-COVID & During COVID



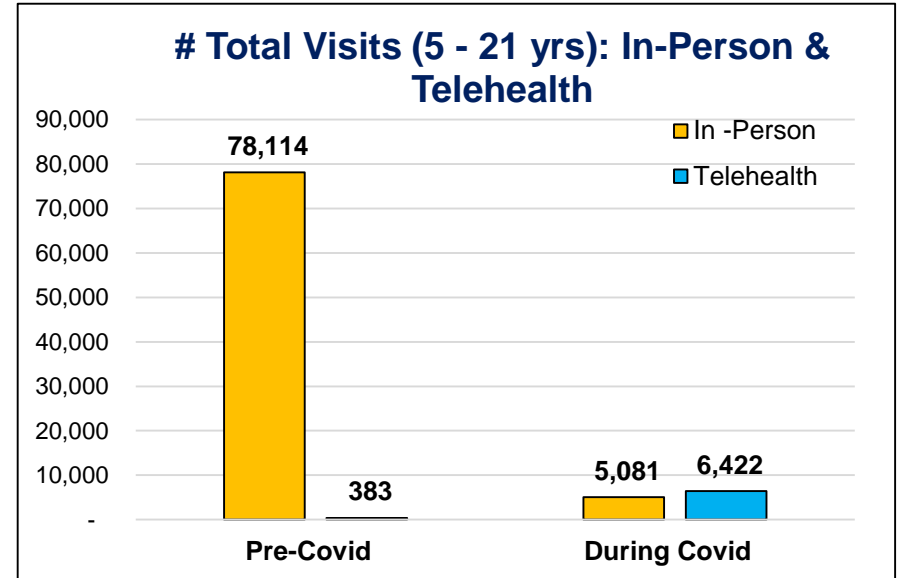
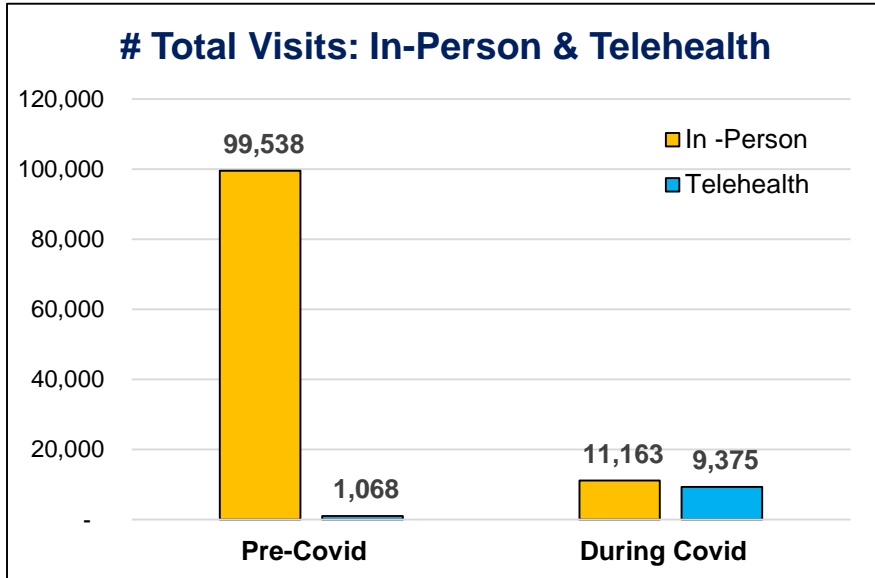
Pre-COVID: 7/1/19 – 3/15/20

#Total Visits: All Clients and 5-21-year-old Clients; 2019-2020: In-Person & Telehealth by Pre-COVID & During COVID

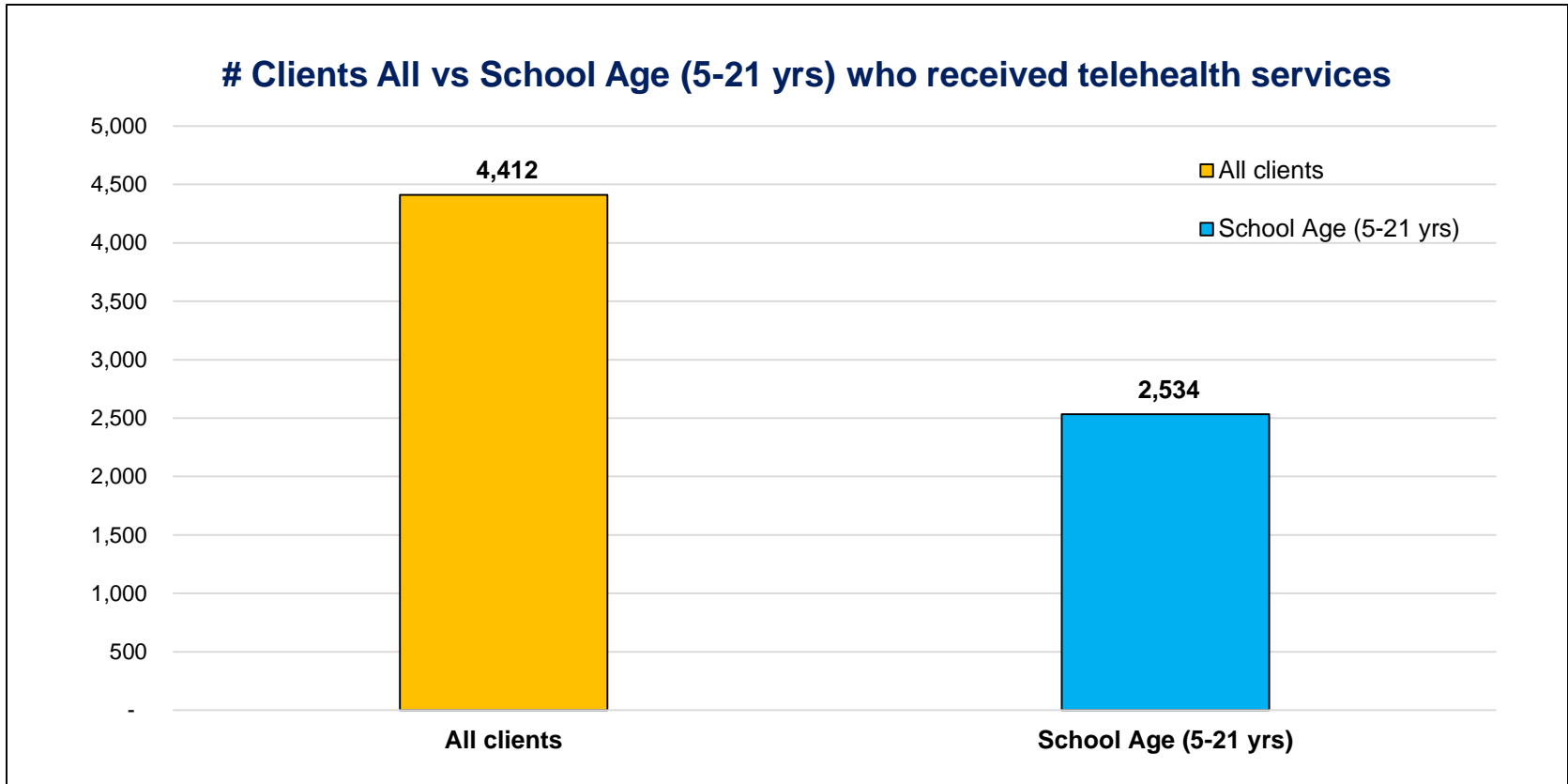

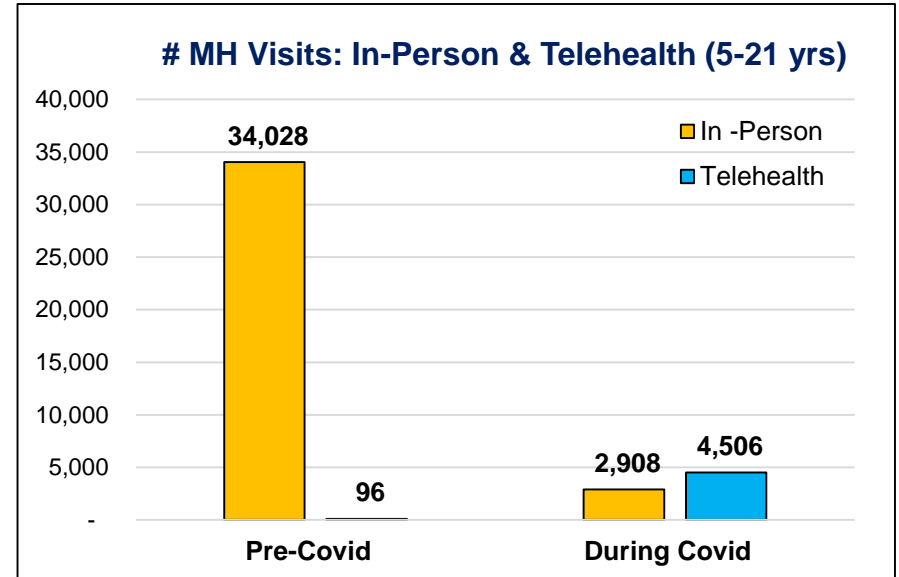
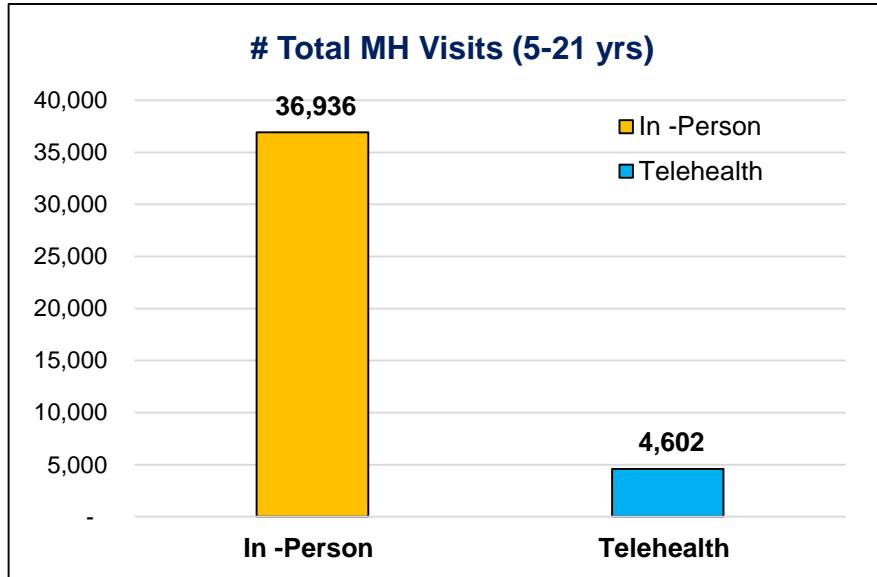

7/1/2019 – 6/30/2020



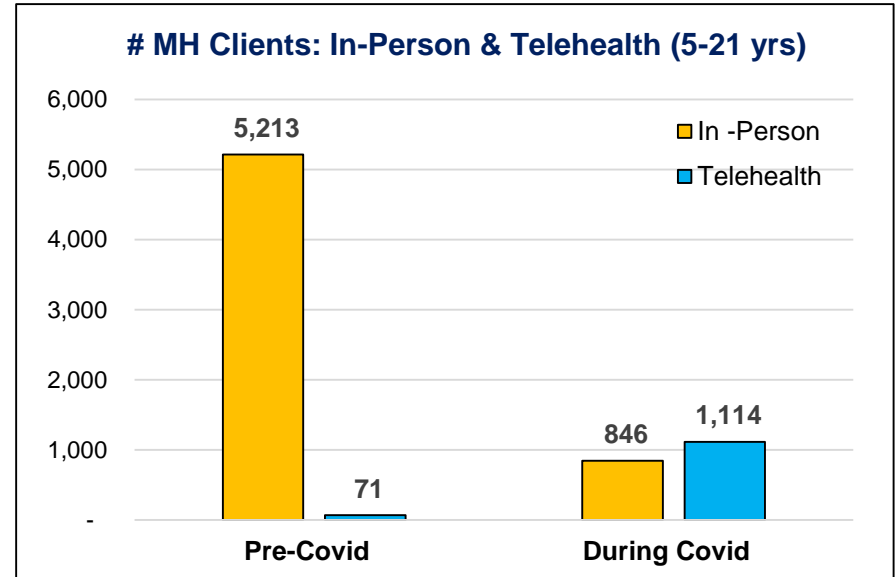
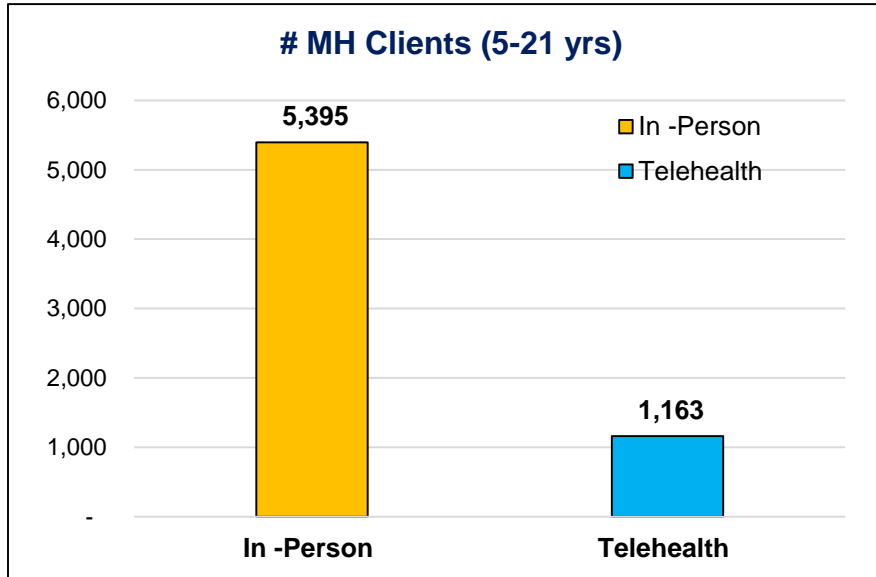
Mental/Behavioral Health Visits (ages 5-21)
