

School-Linked Telehealth Program 25-27 Funding Formula

Once a School-Linked Telehealth site is operational, grantees will need to have their originating sites approved by the SPO within four months of initiating services and meet the Operations Criteria posted on the [OHA website](#).

If approved, funding formula is:

- \$30,000 per site, per year for the first two sites
- \$15,000 per site, per year for up to four additional sites

Thus, the maximum award is \$120,000 per year, and \$240,000 per biennium.

Examples:

- A. If a School-Linked Telehealth Program had 2 originating sites approved, they would receive:

$$\$30,000 + \$30,000 = \$60,000 \text{ per year; } \$120,000 \text{ per biennium}$$

- B. If a School-Linked Telehealth Program had 4 originating sites approved, they would receive:

$$(\$30,000 \times 2) + (\$15,000 \times 2) = \$90,000 \text{ per year; } \$180,000 \text{ per biennium}$$
