- **Please note: You will not find a Vaccine Information Sheet (VIS).** VIS documents are not issued for vaccines under emergency use authorizations. Instead, FDA requires manufacturers to provide an [EUA fact sheet](#). These should be provided to patients and their caregivers.
- **Translations of EUA fact sheets:** CDC has indicated that we can expect FDA to translate the EUA fact sheets and post them on the FDA website by the end of the week. FDA has not indicated the specific link they will use. They have previously made materials available on their [Emergency Use Authorization website](#). Languages that will

be available include: Spanish, Russian, Chinese (Mandarin, Simplified and Traditional), Vietnamese, Somali, Korean, Arabic, Yiddish, Marshallese, Chuukese, Hmong, Mam, Burmese, Portuguese, Khmer, Mein, Haitian Creole, Polish, Hindi, Gujarati, Filipino-Tagalog.
