

Auscultated Acceleration Test

Procedure: Auscultate the FHR for 6 minutes, counting during every other 5-second interval. Document FHRs on graph. If an acceleration of 2 beats per 5-second period does not occur during the initial 2 minutes, then perform an external manual manipulation of the fetus using a 5-second external stimulation procedure.

Interpretation: Identify the baseline FHR. An acceleration is present when the FHR is up by 2 grid points (2 beats per 5-second period - equivalent to 24 bpm acceleration). A single FHR acceleration indicates reactivity.
