Dear OSPHL Clients,

Effective immediately, the Oregon State Public Health Laboratory (OSPHL) is requesting notification of planned QuantiFERON testing events when more than 15 unprocessed (i.e. not yet incubated and centrifuged) samples will be submitted at one time. Advanced notification will ensure proper staffing, reagent supply, and timing of sensitive testing.

The contacts for TB testing event coordination are Caitlin Miranda, Christopher Zielinski, Aspen Baldwin, and Marisa Frieder. To discuss the details of the proposed event, please initiate contact by e-mail to **all** listed contacts. Alternatively, you may contact the OSPHL main line at 503-693-4100 and ask to coordinate a QFT collection event. Requested information will include: the date and time of the planned event, the anticipated number of samples to be submitted, and the need for courier service, collection devices, or test requisitions. This notification should occur, at a minimum, three days before the anticipated date of collection.
