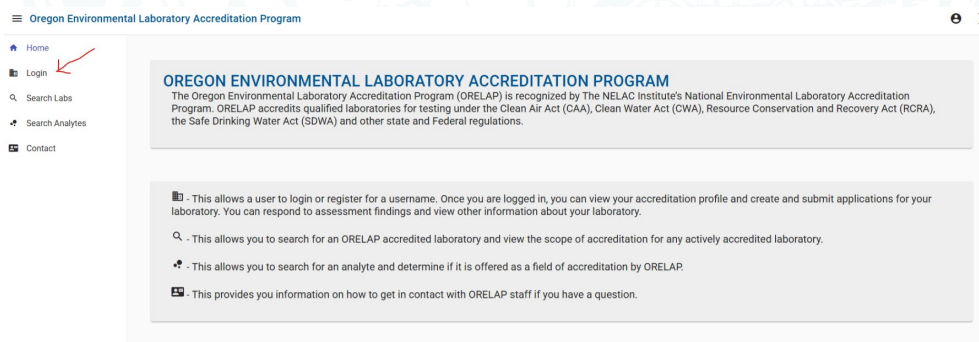
The following contains detailed instructions on how to log into the new URL for ODIE for the first time.

Starting on July 23rd, 2026, please use the following link to access ODIE:

We recommend bookmarking this in your preferred browser for easy access. Our webpages will also contain the updated link.

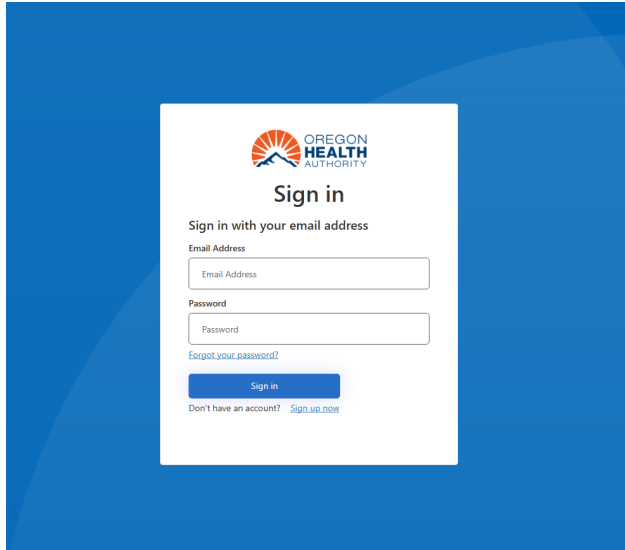
From the home page at the above link, please navigate to the Login screen:



From the Login screen, please select the Login button as shown:

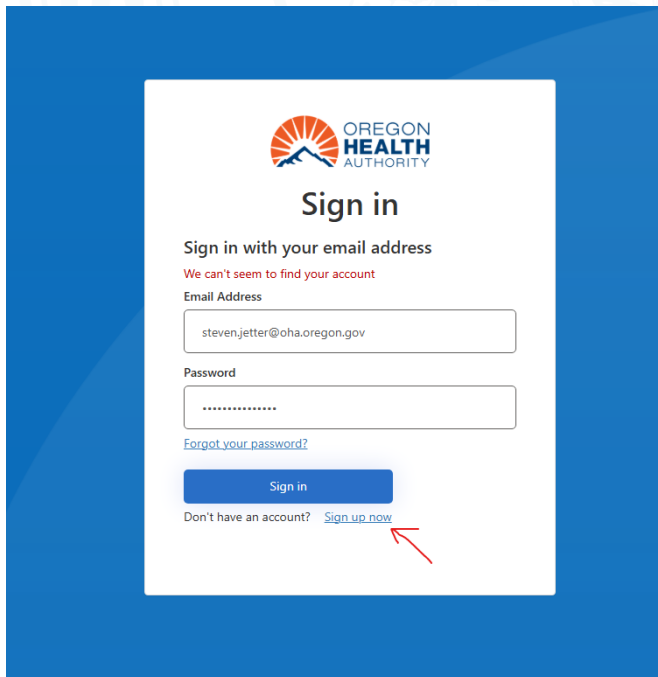


This will open a new web page with a Microsoft B2C (Business-to-Consumer) web address. **This is expected** and is the new multi-factor authentication platform used to log into ODIE.

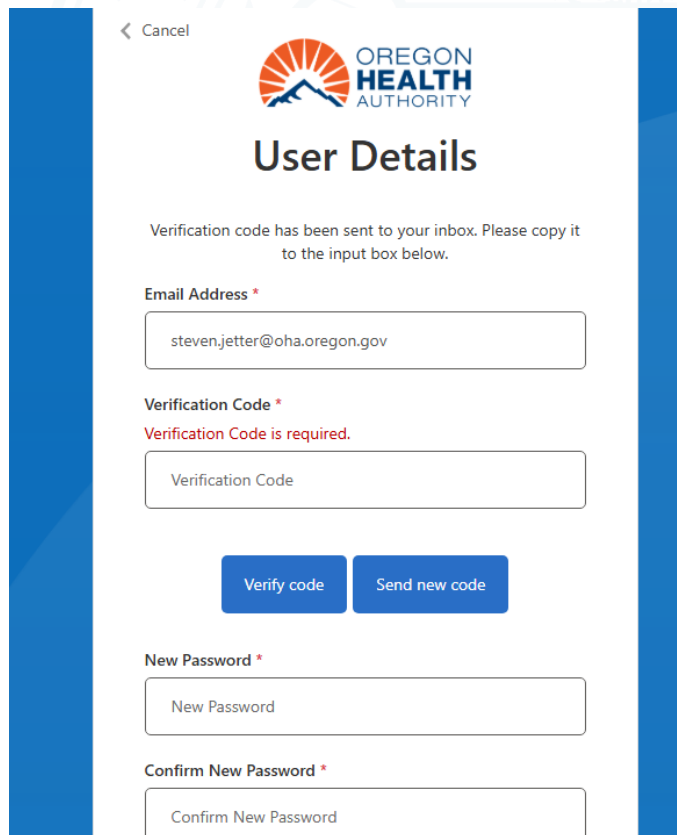

Important: If you do not have access to the email address associated with your user profile in ODIE, you will not be able to continue using that user profile. The multi-factor authentication requires entry of a unique code sent to the email address associated with the user profile in order to log into ODIE.

Not to worry – you can establish a new user profile which ORELAP staff will link to your existing lab. All historical applications and information remain associated with the lab and are available to all user profiles linked to the lab. To request a new user profile, please continue signing up on the authenticator.

Once you click the “Send verification code” button, look for an email from Microsoft on behalf of ORELAP. Enter the code provided in the email as seen here:

After establishing the passwords (given name and surname are optional), click Create and you will be taken back to the ODIE site with your laboratory or laboratories listed. At this point, ODIE will look and function as it has previously.

After initially verifying your email address through B2C, you will only need to enter your email address and password in the B2C authenticator. No unique code will be sent after the email address is verified.

If you needed to create a B2C login using a new email address, you will be taken to the following screen to select an existing laboratory and submit a request for registration of the new user ID:
