AmeriCorps

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) AmeriCorps VISTA Partnership Project is looking for 14 organizations in Oregon to host a full-time volunteer for 1 - 3 years to work on projects that build local capacity to alleviate poverty and improve public health.

Projects must focus on economically disadvantaged communities.

Who can apply?

Nonprofit organizations, as well as, local, state, tribal and federal agencies in Oregon.

What is the cost?

Cost share: \$15,000/year for majority of organizations

Subsidized: \$4,000/year for organizations with highly limited resources and organizations in rural underserved areas of Oregon

What does my organization need to provide?

Host sites develop and supervise the project, mentor the member, and provide necessary administrative support to complete the goals and objectives of the project.

How can I express interest?

Email Caroline.d.tydings@oha.oregon.gov to discuss your project idea ASAP. Organizations are accepted on a rolling basis for the August 2026-2027 service year. Project ideas should be solidified by early May 2026.
