

Demonstrating Flammable Extraction Compliance for Fire Code

Oregon Psilocybin Services administrative rules require that licensed manufactures who use the solvents methanol or ethanol to process psilocybin extracts must be processed in a room with equipment, including all electrical installations that meet the requirements of the Oregon Structural Specialty Code, related Oregon Specialty Codes, and the Oregon Fire Code. (OAR 333-333-2060).

To demonstrate an application meets these requirements a Certificate of Occupancy is required. A Certificate of Occupancy can be issued for the intended use by the appropriate local building official. The certificate must list all equipment used in extraction. Copies of final building permits do not meet this requirement.

A Certificate of Occupancy is required because it demonstrates that the structure is suitable for the proposed extraction use and installed equipment is appropriate for the space where it is located. Safety is a primary concern, and a Certificate of Occupancy helps to demonstrates that the extraction can be done safely at the premises.
