Dear Psilocybin Training Programs,

As part of our continued implementation of Oregon Psilocybin Services (OPS) and related Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR), we are writing to inform you of an important change related to instructor qualifications.

Effective September 1, 2025, at least one instructor at a training program must hold a valid facilitator license in order for the training program to be approved or reapproved, as required under <u>OAR 333-333-3030(5)</u>.

This rule is intended to ensure that at least one instructor has experience meeting the professional and ethical standards expected of licensed facilitators. OPS recognizes the importance of maintaining consistency between facilitation practices in the instruction future facilitators receive in approved training programs.
