Guest Speaker: Francoise Bourzat

- · What safety issues should we be concerned about?
- What is encompassed in integration sessions?
- What are some examples of adverse reactions and how to work with them?

All facilitators should be trained to work with all possible presentations and situations.

Integration consists of processing the content of the experience, assessing and working with the state the recipient presents with after the session, and effectively integrating the things learned in the session into one's life.

Facilitation and integration require attentive listening skills, coaching on the most effective ways to apply and maintain the impact of the experience, and assistance with processing the journey with reflection, motivational interviewing skills.

Discussion of the possibility of facilitators donating some part of their earnings to a scholarship fund to improve accessibility.

Emphasis on the need for supervision and peer support. Suggestion of peer support groups and group facilitation skills workshops led by community for community.

Discussion of medication interactions: Benzodiazepines inhibit psilocybin effects. Antihistamines have had negative outcomes in her experience. SSRI's blunt the effects.
