Dear Local Government Partners:

Oregon Psilocybin Services (OPS) is writing to offer a reminder of the framework and requirements for adopting ordinances that prohibit establishment of psilocybin businesses. Under [ORS 475A](#), local governments may adopt ordinances that prohibit service centers and manufacturers from operating within their local jurisdictions. Ordinances must be approved by voters at the next statewide general election. When a local government adopts an ordinance, they are required to provide a copy of the adopted ordinance to Oregon Psilocybin Services under ORS 475A.538. Ordinances can be sent to the OPS general email address: OHA.Psilocybin@oha.oregon.gov.

When local governments adopt ordinances as described above, OPS compiles the ordinances and lists them on a [Local Ordinance Spreadsheet](#) posted on our website. If your jurisdiction has adopted an ordinance that has since expired or been revoked, please notify OPS so the ordinance may be removed from this listing. Alternatively, if your jurisdiction has adopted an ordinance that is not included in the listing, please provide a copy of the ordinance.
