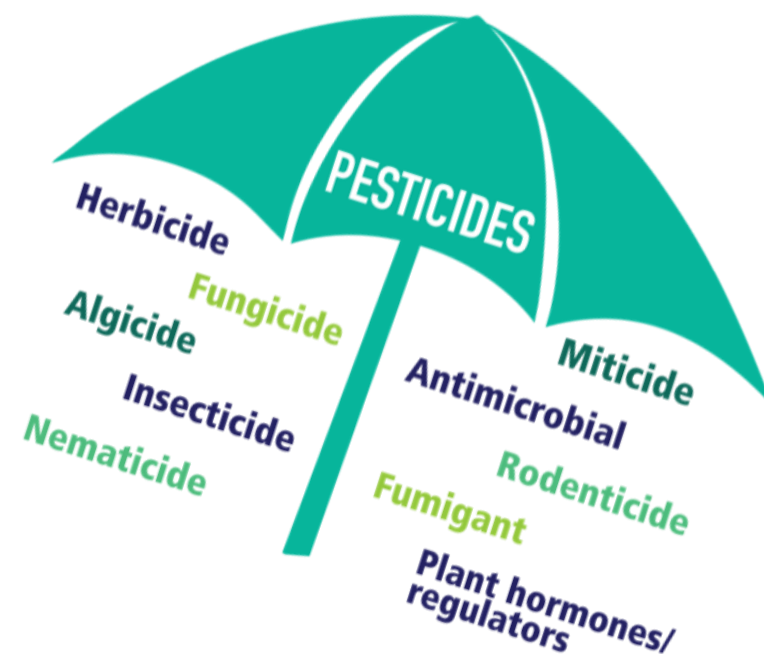

Pesticides

- The label is the law
- No pesticides allowed per OHA rules on fungi or growing medium
- Illegal use can be subject to investigation by ODA



Weights and measures

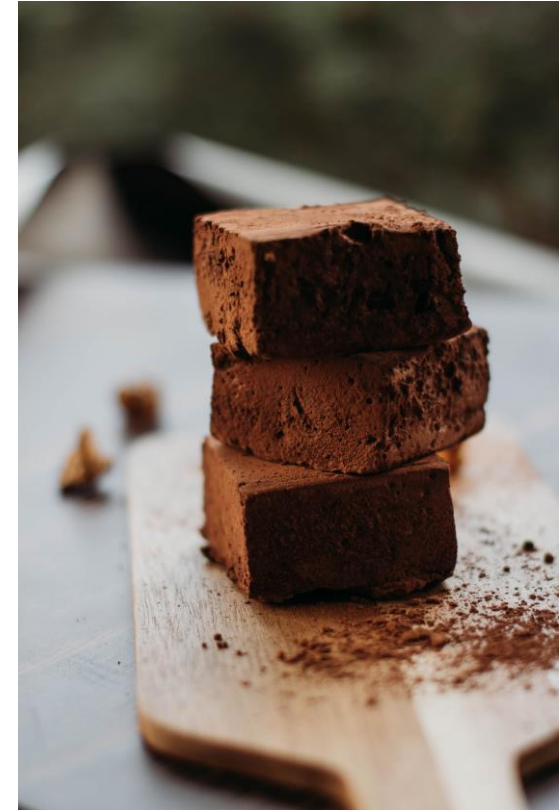
- Buy a legal for trade scale
- Use the correct scale size
- Get a scale inspection/license

Food safety

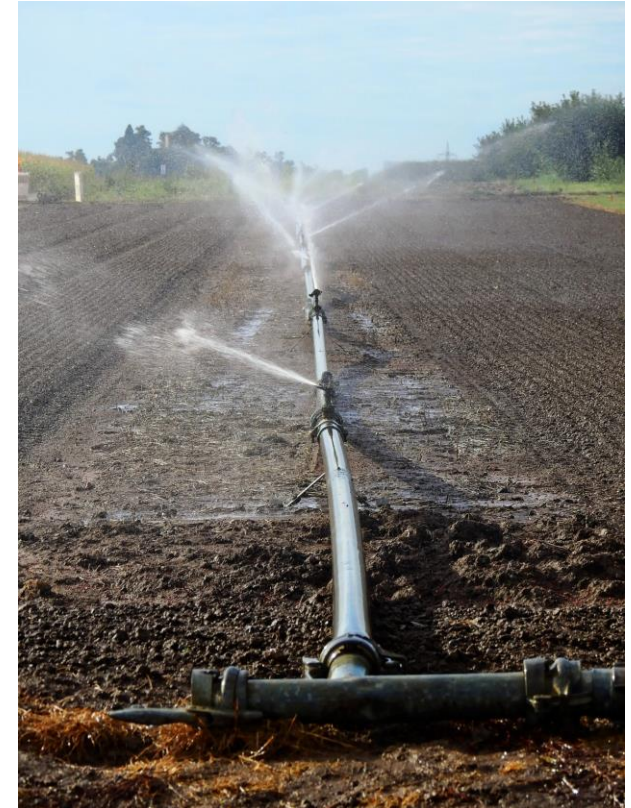
- Making or selling edible food or drink
