

## Child Death Review

### Collaboration Across Medical Providers with Multiple Perspectives

When reviewing a child death, it is important to consider multiple medical perspectives, including any pediatrician with historical knowledge of the child, any physician treating the child in the context of the incident that resulted in the death, and the medical examiner.

The historical, pre-death, and post death perspectives offer valuable and different context for understanding the child's death. When possible, including when there are complex circumstances or inconsistent information, consider:

- Having the medical providers attend the autopsy so information can be exchanged; or
- Asking for a meeting to bring providers together for the purpose of exchanging information
