# Data2Action Project: Supporting Decision-Making Related to Substance Use Prevention, Service Expansion, and Overdose Prevention

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### Grant Information

• Funder: National Institute on Drug Abuse HEAL Data2Action Initiative

- Grant type: Phased (2-part)
  - Phase 1 = Year 1
    - **Learning**, pilot phase (09/2023 08/2024)
  - Phase 2 = Years 2-5
    - State-wide trial

## Phase 1 questions

- What decisions at local (county) and state levels could be better supported by data?
- What data do people most want to support those decisions?
- How do people want to interact with data to inform their decisions?
- Can we obtain the data from someone else (OHA DOJ, etc.) or do we need to collect it?
  - Budgeted for generating service-recipient data

## Milestones\* and Timeline

- 1) List of prioritized data and data sources that could support decisions made at state and **local** levels related to:
  - Substance use disorder prevention
  - Substance use service expansion (filling gaps)
  - Overdose prevention
  - Identifying policy impacts
- 2) Prototypes of products to disseminate data to decision makers
  - Dashboard? Issue Brief? Simulation model?
- 3) Refined processes for sharing and collecting data
- 4) Refined process for co-identifying priorities and co-designing data products
  - ~ 4-6 sessions to prioritize data, co-design data products
