

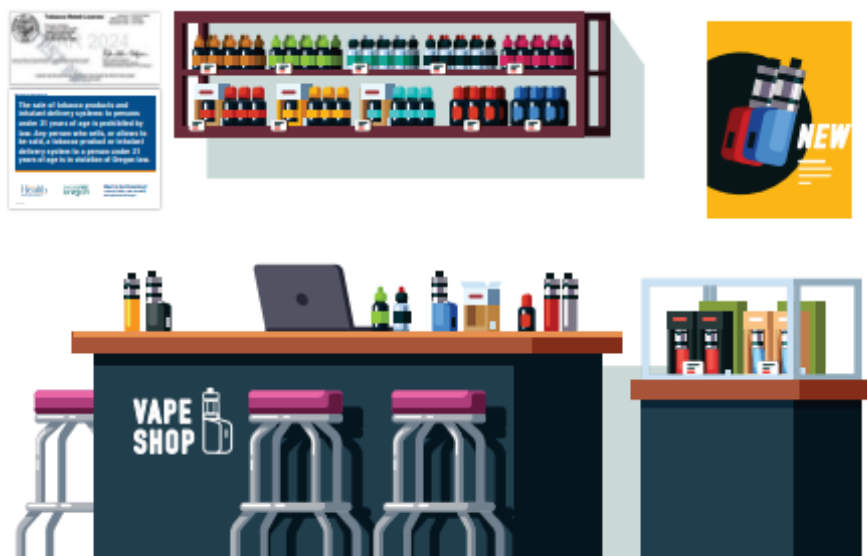
Oregon Tobacco Retail License posting

Did you know that the law requires you to display your Oregon Tobacco Retail License? Failure to post this license where it is clearly visible to employees and customers will result in a violation (Oregon Revised Statute 431A.200).



Examples of where to post the Tobacco Retail License:

- ☐ Behind the retail sales counter
- ☐ Near the retailer entryway
- ☐ On a bulletin board with other posted licenses visible to employees and customers



Examples of where **NOT** to post the Tobacco Retail License:

- ☐ Employee breakrooms
- ☐ Hallways
- ☐ In a manager's office or business office
- ☐ Any location not visible to employees and customers
