

Oregon tobacco 21 notice

Did you know that the law requires you to post a Tobacco 21 Notice? Failure to post it (or a notice substantially similar) where it is clearly visible to employees and customers will result in a violation (Oregon Revised Statute 431A.175).

Here is what the notice looks like:

ORS 431A.175, ORS 431A.178

The sale of tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems to persons under 21 years of age is prohibited by law. Any person who sells, or allows to be sold, a tobacco product or inhalant delivery system to a person under 21 years of age is in violation of Oregon law.
