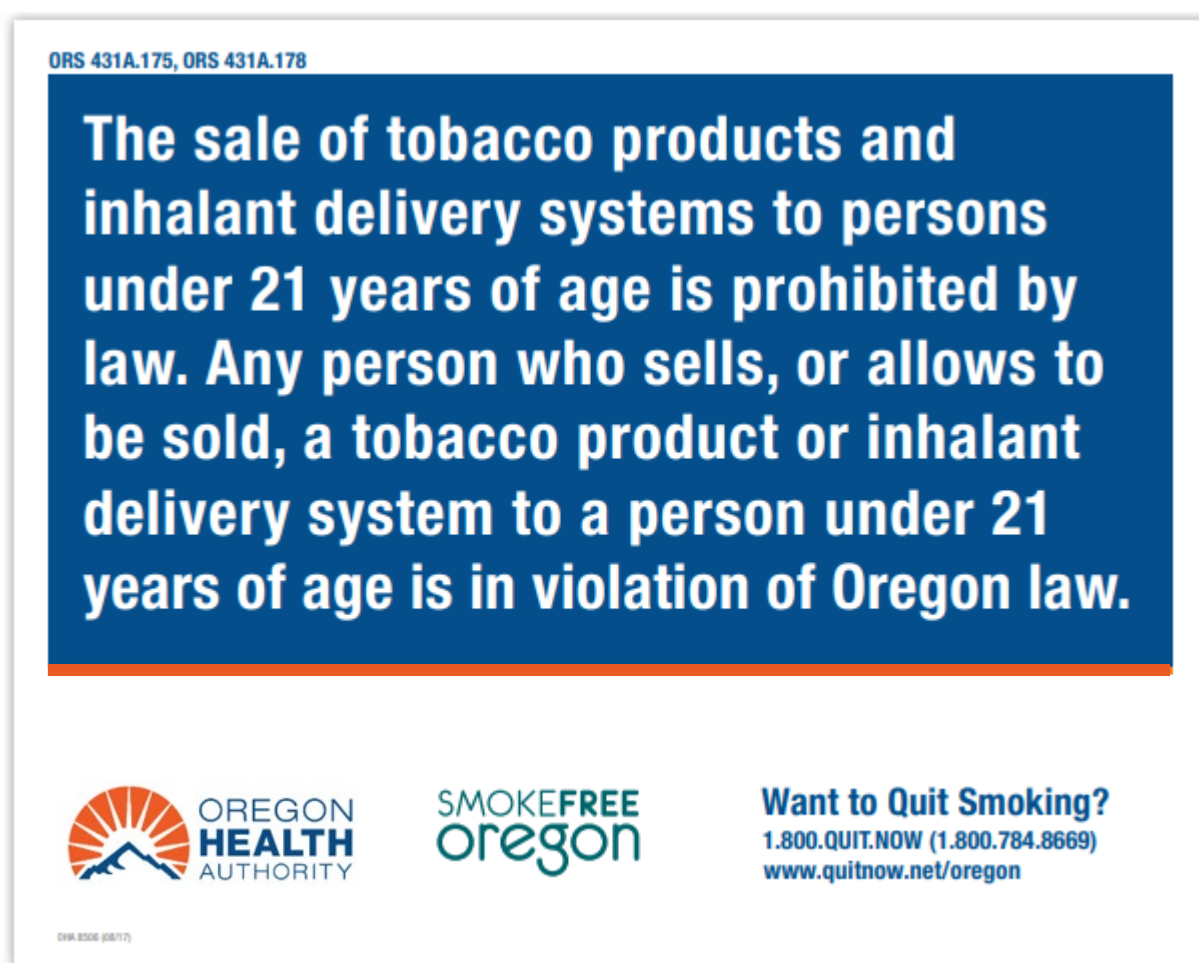


Oregon tobacco 21 notice

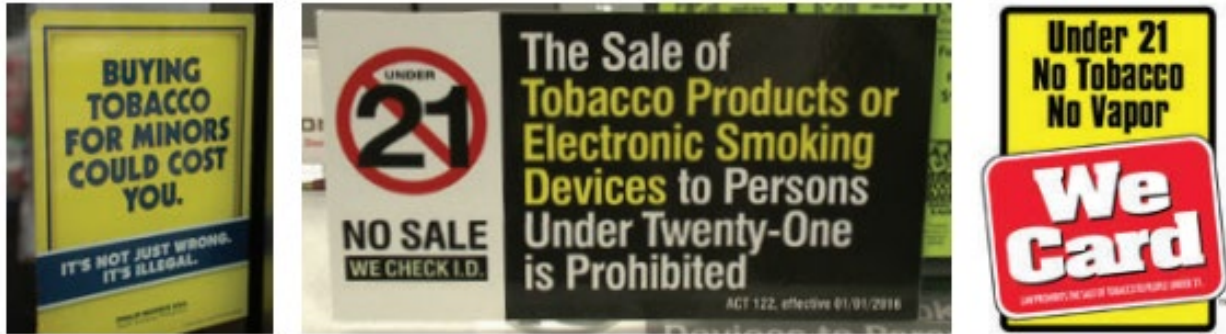
Did you know that the law requires you to post a Tobacco 21 Notice? Failure to post it (or a notice substantially similar) where it is clearly visible to employees and customers will result in a violation (Oregon Revised Statute 431A.175).

Here is what the notice looks like:

You may also post signs such as the ones below or similar. However, it's important to know these signs alone do **NOT** meet the state requirement.
