

# No self-service tobacco products


Did you know that the law requires you to keep **ALL** tobacco products behind the counter in an area only employees can get to **OR** in a locked case? If you keep tobacco products where customers can get them without help from a clerk, it will result in a violation (Oregon Revised Statute 167.765). An exception to this is if the business prohibits customers younger than 21.

## Steps to comply with the no self-service law:

- ☐ If a customer looks younger than 30, always check their ID.
- □ Place tobacco products only where customers cannot get them without help.

#### How to do this:

- ☐ Place all tobacco products behind the counter or in an area that only employees can get to.
- ☐ Keep tobacco products in a locked case that only employees can get to.
