


## Oregon Tobacco Retail License Posting

Did you know that the law requires you to display your Oregon Tobacco Retail License? A failure to post this license where it is clearly visible to employees and customers will result in a violation (Oregon Revised Statute 431A.200).



Examples of where to post the Tobacco Retail License:

- ❑ Behind the retail sales counter
- ❑ Near the retailer entryway
- ❑ On a bulletin board with other posted licenses visible to employees and customers



Examples of where **NOT** to post the Tobacco Retail License:

- ❑ Employee breakrooms
- ❑ Hallways
- ❑ In a managers office or business office
- ❑ Any location not visible to employees and customers
