Instructions for Immunization Reports

Page 4 - Sections F, G, H

Complete this from when all the student records have been updated, no later than the due date listed on the form. Fill out this form even if all the records have not yet been updated.

Complete section F for students in kindergarten, complete section G for students in seventh grade, and complete section H for all students in kindergarten through twelfth grade (including the kindergartners and seventh graders from sections F and G).

Only count the students included on the section A report who are still enrolled. Do not count new students or those who left since you turned in the initial report.

Students younger than kindergarten are counted in section E, page 3. This page is for grades K-12.

How many students in grades K-12 were excluded on Exclusion Day?

This is the number of students in grades K-12 excluded at the start of school on Exclusion Day.

<u>Total enrollment</u>: This is the total number of students enrolled in grades K-12.

<u>Students not counted</u>: Students who attend more than one school or facility and spend more time at the other site should be included in this number.

Adjusted enrollment: This is the total enrollment minus the students not counted.

No record: Students who have no immunization records or exemptions on file should be counted here. If all the records have been updated, this number should be zero.

<u>Medical exemptions</u>: This is any student that has a temporary or permanent medical exemption that has been approved by the local health department.

Nonmedical exemptions: This is any child that has a nonmedical exemption for one or more vaccines. Include the number of children with a nonmedical exemption from the online vaccine education module or a health care practitioner.

Number with vaccines: DTaP/Tdap, Polio, Varicella, MMR1, MMR2, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis A, and All: Fill in the number of students who are complete for that vaccine (with the specified number of doses). In the MMR1 category, fill in the number of students with at least one dose of MMR (measles/mumps/rubella) vaccine. In the MMR2 category, fill in the number of students with two doses of MMR or measles vaccine.

Tip: The MMR1 cannot be less than MMR2. In the All category, fill in the number of students that are complete for all the vaccines required at their grade level. Include students with a history of disease or immunity documentation. Tip: If a student is complete for a vaccine and has an exemption for that vaccine, only count the child in the vaccine category and not the exemption category.

Number with nonmedical exemptions: DTaP/Tdap, Polio, Varicella, MMR1, MMR2, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis A, and All: Fill in the number of students who have a nonmedical exemption for each vaccine. In the MMR1 category, include students who have a nonmedical exemption to MMR and no MMR vaccines. In the MMR2 category, include students who have zero doses of MMR, or one dose of MMR but claimed an exemption for the second dose of MMR. Tip: The MMR1 number for exemptions cannot be greater than the MMR2 number for exemptions. In the All category, count the number of students with nonmedical exemptions for every vaccine required for their grade. Be sure to count them in the individual nonmedical exemption categories as well.
