VAC Proposed Sequencing Suggestions

- Black, African American, Hispanic/Latinx/o, Indigenous, tribal and urban based Natives, Pacific Islander. In short, the people who experience the impacts of racism and health disparity on a daily basis and are currently experiencing the highest rates of COVID-19 in the state.
- Refugees
- Adults 16-64 with chronic conditions
- Adults and youth eligible for vaccine in custody (sequence within 1b)
- Frontline workers (not already in Phase 1a or 1b)
- Multi-generational homes
- Low-income senior housing and other congregate senior housing-people under the age of 65

OHA Follow up items

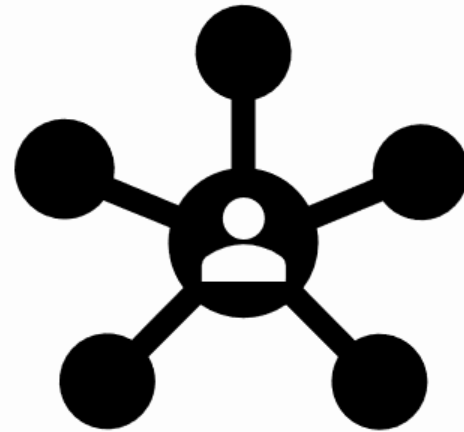
- The VAC Requested that OHA: share data about those identified groups
- Additionally, OHA has submitted the draft prioritization documentation to the Department of Justice for review

Data Sources

- American Community Survey
- Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System Survey (BRFSS)
- Department of Corrections
- Oregon Youth Authority

Things to keep in mind

- Intersectional identities- people can and do fit into multiple categories and the numbers might be misleading
- Numbers are estimates for planning purposes only
- Logistics of vaccine delivery should be considered for expediency
