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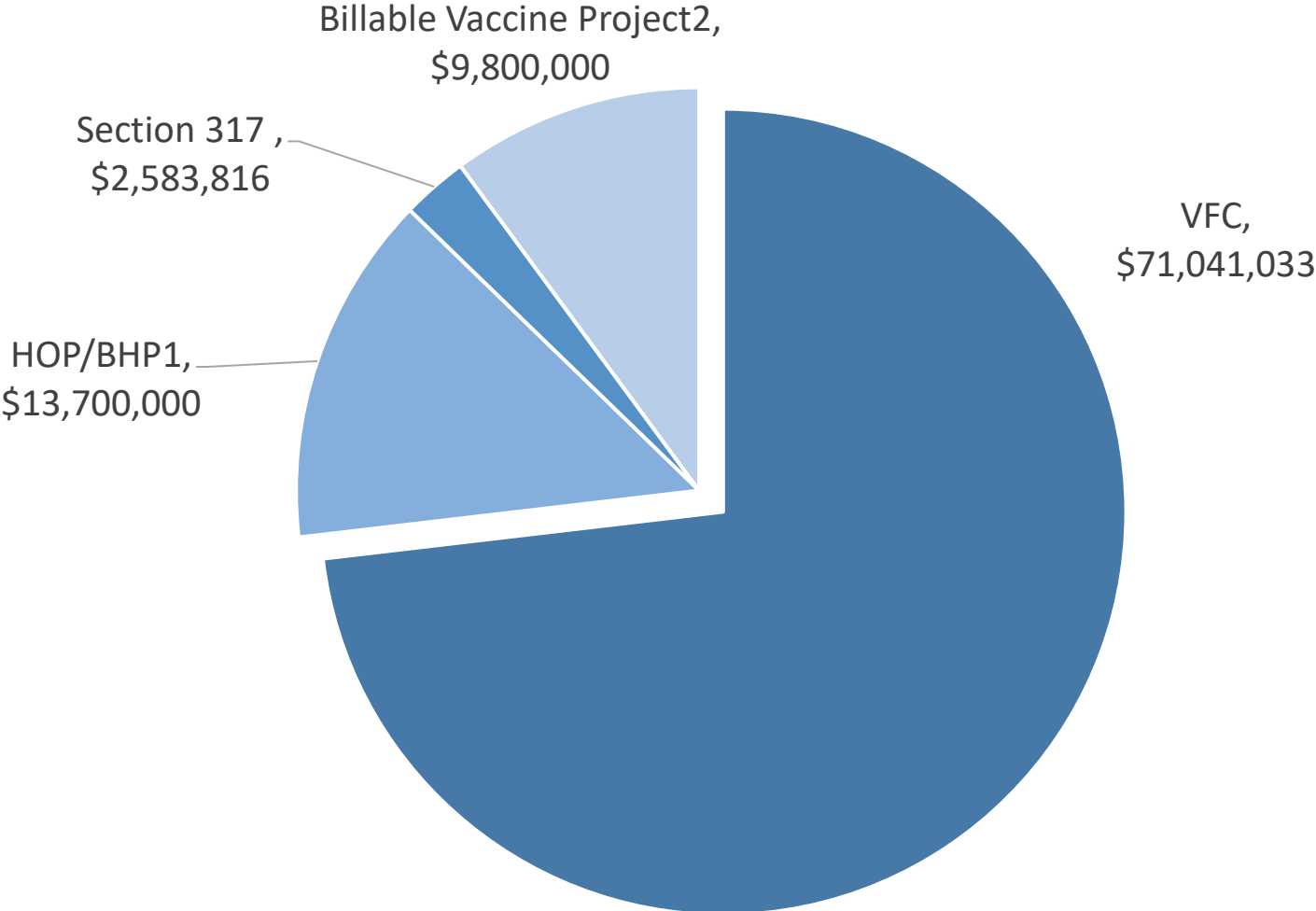
Vaccine Acquisition & Distribution

- OIP supplies vaccine to ~700 clinics/agencies across the state.
 - LPHAs - Local Public Health Authority sites
 - ITUs – Indian, Tribal and Urban Indian sites and centers
 - Private medical providers
 - Department of Corrections and Oregon Youth Authority
 - FQHCs – Federally Qualified Health Centers
 - Community based clinics
 - Mobile health units
 - Naturopathic doctors

- = 46% (~300 clinics)

- Other 54% are private VFC only clinics
