

Oregon Vaccines for Children (VFC) Vaccines

The Oregon VFC Program supplies vaccines according to the ACIP (Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices) and our Medical Director. VFC-eligible children and adolescents (birth through age 18) are those without health insurance, those on Medicaid, and those who are Native American or Alaskan Native. In addition, underinsured children and adolescents are eligible when served at an official Rural Health Clinic or Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC).
