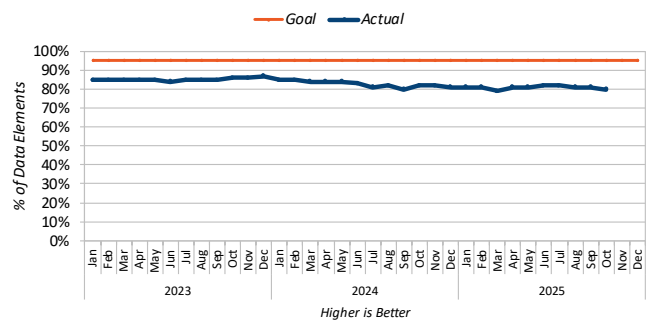
C4. GCS Recorded—Trauma



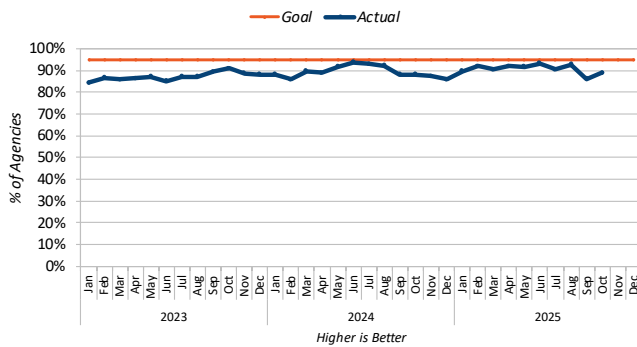

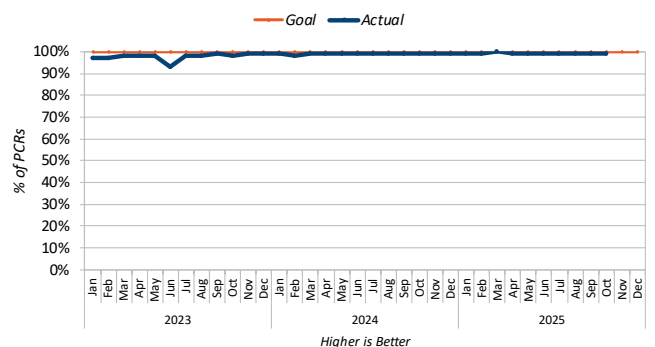
C5. Scene and Injury Details Recorded—Transport Incidents



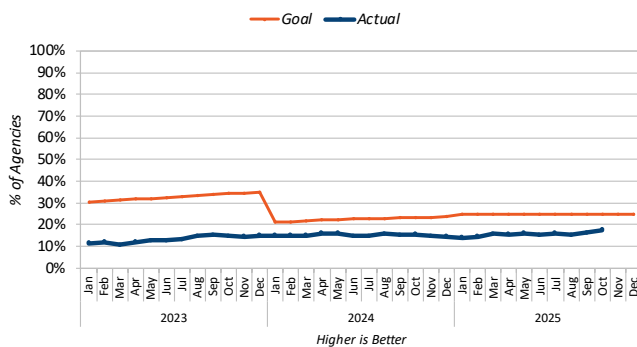
C2. Agencies Submitting PCR's—Transport



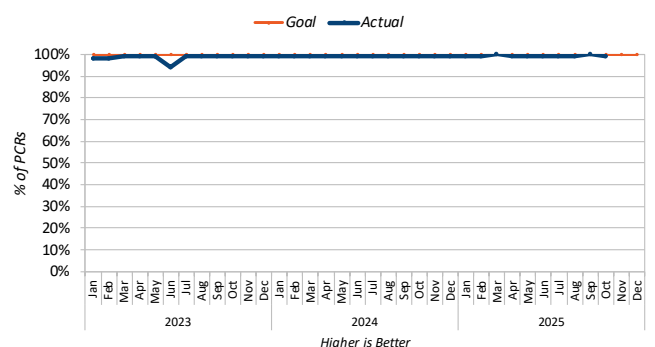
C7. Patient Age Recorded

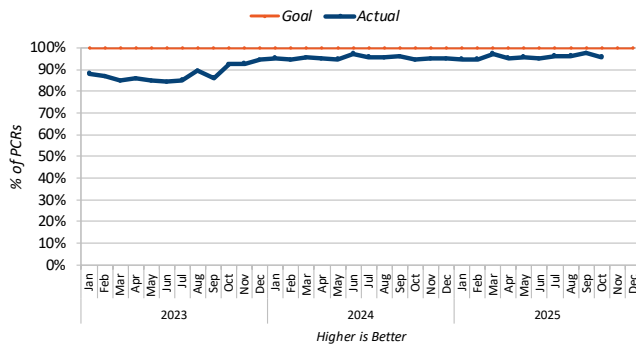

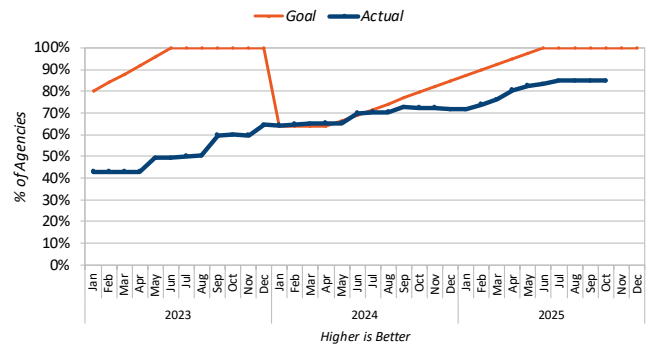

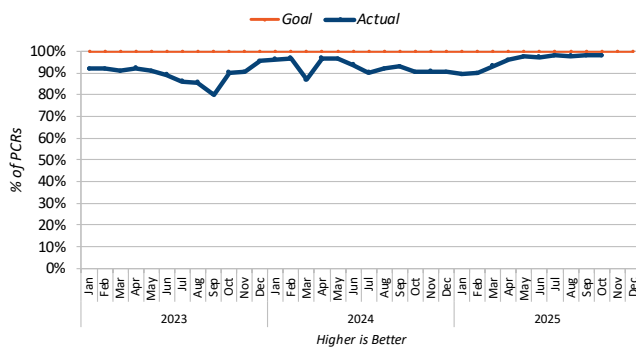
C9. Additional Response Mode Descriptors Recorded



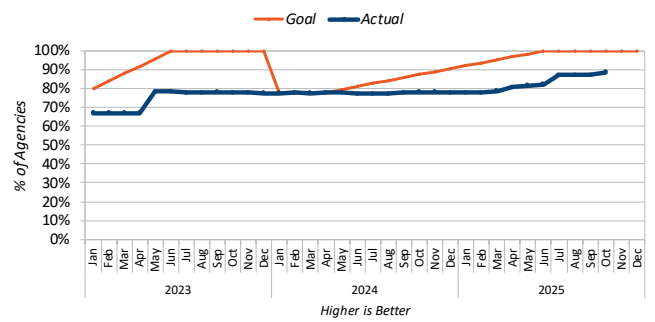
I1. Licensing System Integration—Transport Agencies



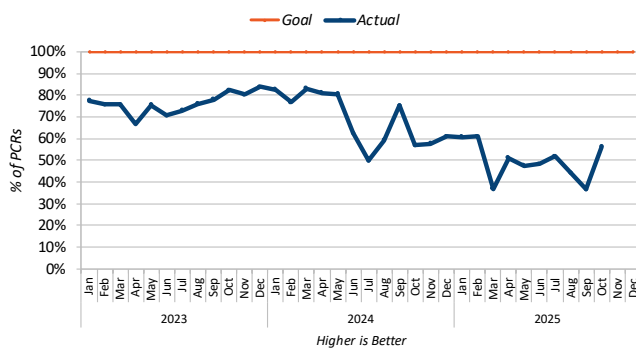
C10. Additional Transport Mode Descriptors Recorded



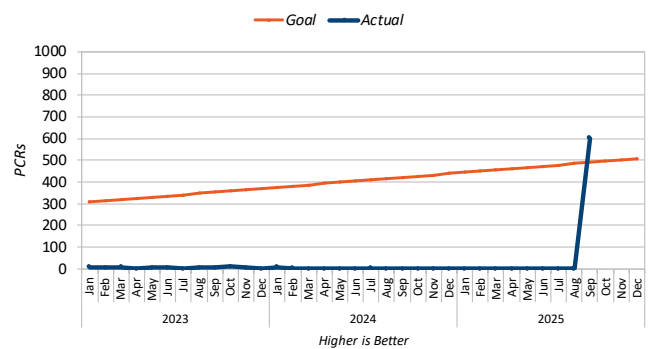

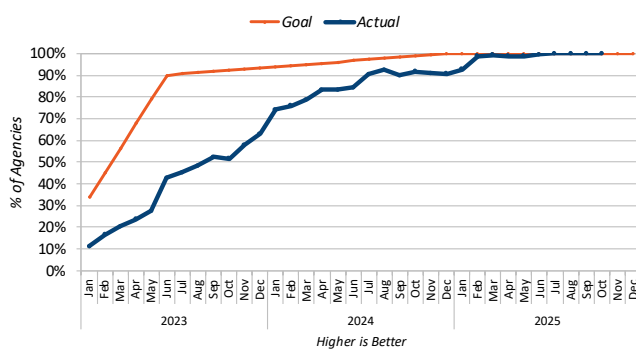

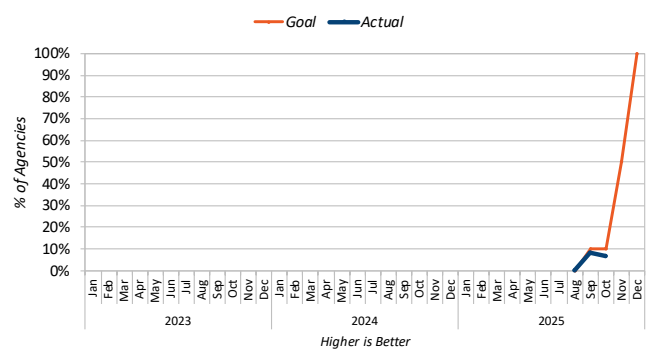

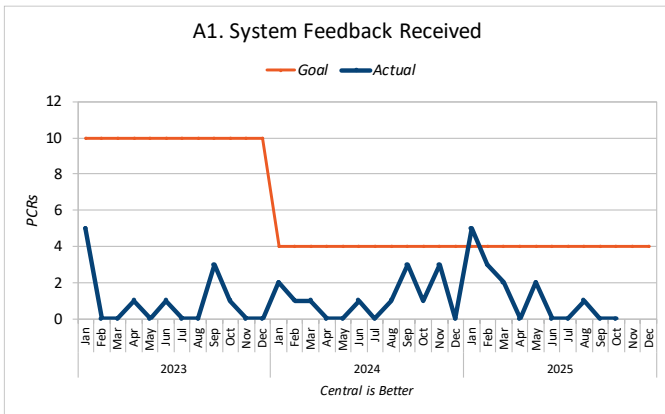
