




## Unintentional Drowning Death Rate of US Infants and Children Ages 0-19 by Gender, 1981-2017



In 2018: 913 total unintentional drowning deaths



## **Unintentional** Drowning Death Rate of US Infants and Children, by Age Group, 1981-2017







### Overall Water Location Type; Ages 0 to 4





### Overall Water Location Type; Ages 10 to 14



### Overall Water Location Type; Ages 5 to 9




### Overall Water Location Type; Ages 15 to 17

ABSTRACT. Drowning is a leading cause of injury-related death in children. In 2017, drowning claimed the lives of almost 1000 US children younger than 20 years. A number of strategies are available to prevent these tragedies. As educators and advocates, pediatricians can play an important role in the prevention of drowning.



### BACKGROUND

Drowning is the leading cause of injury death in US children 1 through 4 years of age and the third leading cause of unintentional injury death among US children and adolescents 5 through 19 years of age. In 2017, drowning claimed the lives of almost 1000 US children.

Fortunately, childhood unintentional drowning fatality rates have decreased steadily from 2.68
