



Tylenol Dosing Instructions for Children

our child's last dose of Tylenol® (acetaminophen concentration:mgm vasmg (mL) atam/pm	L)

- Acetaminophen (Tylenol®) may be given every 4-6 hours
- Do NOT give more than 5 doses in a 24-hour period.
- **ALWAYS** check any other medications for the active ingredient Acetaminophen (i.e. over-the-counter cold medicine, Vicodin, Norco, etc.) and include these medications in your day's total doses.
- ALWAYS speak with your doctor before giving acetaminophen to any child under 3 months old.

- Ibuprofen (Motrin®, Advil®) may be given every 6-8 hours.
- Do not exceed 4 doses in a 24 hour period.
- Always speak with your doctor before giving ibuprofen to any child under 6 months old.
