The Oregon Behavioral Health Coordination Center (OBCC) is a state-funded program with a mission to improve access to behavioral health and substance use disorder beds in Oregon. We are led and operated by Oregon Health & Science University and function as a resource to behavioral health collaborators across the state.

OUR GOALS

- Accurately track and report behavioral health and substance use disorder bed census across Oregon in real-time.
- Facilitate transfers to treatment facilities by identifying resources in a timely manner.
- Improve equitable access to care.
- Reduce work for Oregon behavioral health practitioners.

HOW TO ACTIVATE



Call OBCC to begin an activation for a patient or client of any age.



Provide us with basic demographics and referral information.



Patient Transfer Coordinators will locate facilities by prioritizing appropriate level of care, relative distance to the client's home county, and fidelity of service.



Once a bed is found, we will connect the two facilities and close the activation.
