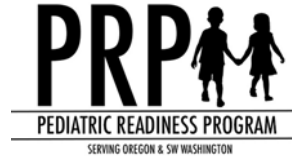

**Oregon Poison Center Training**

Participants will learn about poison control centers, identify common poisons and prevention strategies, learn what to do in case of a poisoning, and how to share your knowledge with
