Dear EMS Stakeholders,

As part of routine maintenance of the Oregon EMS Information System (OR-EMSIS), the State EMS Office in conjunction with the EMS data workgroup has made updates to the state data set and state Schematron. A summary of the updates are attached in PDF format. The updated files are available at <u>nemsis.org/state-data-managers/state-map-v3/oregon</u>.

The updates and implementation timeline were finalized at the state level in early May of 2019, and they were approved and published by NEMSIS on May 9, 2019.

If your agency uses the OR-EMSIS system as a direct data entry source, these updates will occur automatically with no work on your part.

If your agency uses a third party ePCR software vendor, such as Emergency Reporting, ESO, HealthEMS, iPCR, MEDS, ZOLL, **or an agency-purchased ImageTrend Elite system**, you will need to work directly with your vendor to ensure that the updates are completed for your software and compliant with OR-EMSIS within 30 days. You or your vendor need to do the following:

- Update your procedure, medication, agency, and facility lists as needed to match the changes in the Oregon state data set.
- Deploy the updated Oregon Schematron schemas in your system.

Vendors will need to deploy the Schematron and state data set updates by 07/15/2019. If you have questions regarding this update, please feel free to contact us.
