



**INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRICTED EMS PROVIDER LICENSE
Oregon Administrative Rule 333-265-0056**

Purpose:

To authorize an out-of-state EMS provider to treat individuals involved in responding to a wildland fire in Oregon.

Qualifications:

- The individual must be licensed and in good standing as an EMS provider in another state.
- The individual must hold a current certification from the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT).

Procedure:

1. The agency manager, medical unit leader or designated representative will contact the Oregon EMS office with the request for temporary licensure.

2. The Application for Temporary Restricted EMS Licensure will be provided to the agency representative.
NOTE: a separate background check may be required.
3. The agency representative will return the completed applications as well as the name of the supervising physician providing oversight during the wildland medical operations to the Oregon EMS office.

4. The Oregon EMS and Trauma Systems office will notify the agency representative when each license is approved. A temporary restricted license for each individual will be generated and emailed to the agency representative and/or medical unit leader.
