
#### Claiming a license: Step 1



Sign in to your agency's online license account



### Claiming a license: Step 2




Choose "In Home Care" from the dashboard options.

## Claiming a license: Step 3



Enter the Owner Name, the License number (ex. 15-1000), physical address, city, state and zip

#### Claiming a license: Final Step



Once the information has been entered, a link titled "Claim" will appear in the bottom right-hand corner. Press the link.

### What happens after you claim a license?

- An IHC staff member will be notified and will approve or deny the request to claim.
- Approval and denial of claims notifications are sent via email.
- Once approved, an agency can make any licensure changes and renew its license within 60 days of licensure expiration.
- Online payments are now accepted through the online licensing system.
