To whom it may concern:

The Oregon Public Health Division is the sole Public Health Authority in Oregon that will accept data for the Meaningful Use (MU) menu option of successful ongoing submission of cancer incidence case information.

Due to budgetary constraints, the Oregon State Cancer Registry (OSCaR) is **INDEFINITELY UNABLE** to accept electronic cancer incidence data from Eligible Providers (EPs) who are preparing to submit these data using certified EHR technology. OSCaR does not have the capacity to onboard and process HL7 CDA cancer incidence reports and these data **will not be accepted** from Eligible Providers (EPs).

OSCaR will reassess the furlough of the Meaningful Use program as program infrastructure allows. We encourage Meaningful Use participants, in Oregon, to check the OHA Public Health Meaningful Use website (healthoregon.org/mu) for updates. We thank you for your patience.
