In-Kind Support = These are non-cash contributions. These are costs that are covered by the LPHA/County as in-kind and do not appear in the LPHA's account systems and reports. Contribution amounts should be based on the fair market value of the contributions. (Example: LPHA uses a county-owned or leased building but is not charged rent either directly or through indirect costs). In-kind support can only be counted once.
