Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Public Health Division (PHD) conducted the triennial review of Wheeler County Public Health during June 12-July 17, 2024.

The Local Public Health Administrator, Shelby Thompson, will receive reports for each program area reviewed, any compliance findings, and the corrective actions required to resolve the findings. OHA-PHD staff determined findings based on compliance with federal and state statutes or rules, the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Financing of Public Health Services (PH-IGA), and the Intergovernmental Agreement for Environmental Health Services (EH-IGA).

The review included appraisal of items in the program areas listed below. Program areas that had compliance findings are indicated with an asterisk.
