Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Public Health Division (PHD) conducted the triennial review of Benton County Public Health during October 2-27, 2023. This letter informs you that the review is closed.

The Local Public Health Authority (LPHA) Administrator, April Holland, will receive reports for each program area reviewed, any compliance findings, and the corrective actions required to resolve the findings. OHA-PHD staff determined findings based on compliance with federal and state statutes or rules, the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Financing of Public Health Services (PH-IGA), and the Intergovernmental Agreement for Environmental Health Services (EH-IGA).
