Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Public Health Division (PHD) conducted the triennial review of Douglas County Public Health during May of 2024.

The Local Public Health Administrator, Dr. Dannenhoffer, will receive reports for each program area reviewed, any compliance findings, and the corrective actions required to resolve the findings. OHA-PHD staff determined findings based on compliance with federal and state statutes or rules, the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Financing of Public Health Services (PH-IGA), and the Intergovernmental Agreement for Environmental Health Services (EH-IGA).

The review included appraisal of items in the program areas listed below. Program areas that had compliance findings are indicated with an asterisk.
