
Graph 1. Total number of hospital births and percent of women with a reported hepatitis B surface antigen (HBSAg) status in the birth record, Oregon, 2003-2019


Graph 2. Total number of hospital births and percent of infants reported in the birth record to have received the hepatitis B birth dose, Oregon, 2003-2019


