Length of Quarantine Period Can be Modified

OHA guidelines provides an option for a 10-day quarantine period instead of 14 days. A new “Quarantine Period” field was added to give the option for either a 14- or 10-day quarantine period.

- By default, the “Quarantine Period” will be 14 days
- However, if the option of “10 days” is selected, the “End of Quarantine Period” will be 10 days after the “Date of Last Exposure”

Descriptions Added for Each Monitoring Status

New “Monitoring Status Description” field has been added below the “Monitoring Status” field. This provides a description of the “Monitoring Status” that has been selected:

- **Monitoring:** This contact is active and is receiving automatic or manual texts/emails/phone calls.
- **Completed Monitoring:** This contact has finished symptom monitoring and quarantine.
- **Opted Out:** This contact has declined to participate in daily symptom monitoring.
- **Lost to Follow-up:** Contact tracer attempted to call contact 3 times and was unable to reach them.
- **Transferred to Opera:** This contact has become a case and was transferred to Opera.
- **Marked for deduplication:** This contact record is a duplicate and is marked as inactive.
- **Identified not to be a contact:** This contact was never exposed.
- **Out of state:** This contact lives outside of Oregon.
- **Education / Notification Complete:** This contact is not a high-risk contact and does not need daily follow-up under surge guidance.





System List View Updated: “My active contacts without recent assessments”

BEFORE: Only contacts who haven’t completed an assessment in more than 1 day appeared, contacts who never completed an assessment did not appear.

AFTER: Contacts who haven’t completed an assessment in more than 1 day **and** those have never completed an assessment will appear.

System List View Updated: “My contacts with symptoms”

BEFORE: Both Active and Deactivated contacts appeared.

AFTER: Only Active contacts will appear.
