



Dates Are Now Standardized for Questions Which Require a Date

BEFORE: Depending on the language in the “Email / Text Language” field, how the contact entered in a date for questions with a calendar was different:

When did you first start noticing symptoms?
<input type="text" value="3/1/2021"/> 
언제 증상이 나타났습니까
<input type="text" value="2021-03-01"/> 
Когда Вы впервые заметили симптомы
<input type="text" value="01.03.2021"/> 

AFTER: Regardless of which language is in the “Email / Text Language” field, how the contact enters in a date for questions with a calendar is all in this same format: “**MM/DD/YYYY**”:

“MM/DD/YYYY” Label Added to Questions Which Require a Date

Since the way contacts enter in dates has been changed, a label has been added to the end of all questions with a calendar to show the correct way to enter in a date:

When did you first start noticing symptoms? (MM/DD/YYYY)
03/01/2021 
언제 증상이 나타났습니까 (월/일/연도)
03/01/2021 
Когда Вы впервые заметили симптомы (MM/ДД/ГГГГ)

Warning Message Added: “US Cellular Incompatible for Text Messages”

- The cell phone carrier “US Cellular” is **not** compatible for automated text messages
- If “Automated Monitoring” is “Yes”, the following warning message will appear to notify: **“US Cellular incompatible for text messages.”**
 - If the contact has US Cellular and access to email, please offer automated email assessments.

New “Monitoring Status” option added: “Monitoring Not Recommended”

- “Monitoring not recommended” has been added as a “Monitoring Status”
- The “Monitoring Status Description” is “Contact does not need to be monitored”
- This status is intended for contacts who have been vaccinated and do not need to be monitored
