## Added Option for 10-day Quarantine Period

In response to the most recent guidance from OHA, the shortened 10-day quarantine is now recommended under certain conditions.

## Added “Warning” when an Unsupported Language is Selected

When a language is selected that is not supported for automated email or text assessments, a Warning message pops up below the Email / Text Language field indicating that the language selected is not supported for automated assessments.

- Automated Assessments are available in English, Spanish, Korean, Russian, Chinese (Cantonese), Chinese (Mandarin), and Vietnamese.
- If an unsupported language is selected, automated assessments will default to English. You do not need to update the Email/Text Language field to “English”.

## REALD Question Format Update

The “If Yes” questions on the REALD tab are hidden until ‘Yes’ is selected as the answer to the primary question. This helps to streamline the REALD data collection process by removing questions from the page until they are needed.
