Addition of 5-Day Quarantine Option

On December 29, 2021, the Oregon Health Authority issued new [Investigative Guidelines](#), following new guidance from the CDC. This guidance includes a 5-day quarantine option for many situations involving exposure to COVID-19.

- **Quarantine Period** will now include an option for 5 days from the drop-down menu
