
- Users will no longer be able to access the Test (Sandbox) Environment starting 9/1/20

- A warning message will appear asking if you want to save your changes when you navigate to a new screen


Assessment Completion Status

- Completed: An assessment that is opened and successfully submitted




Assessment List View - "Other Symptoms" added to list view

- A column has been added to the Assessment list view that informs if there is any text entered in the "If other symptoms, please explain" textbox in the assessment
- If there is no text, it will show "No"
- If text has been entered in, the column will show "Yes"



Character Limit Increased in the Additional Notes field

Additional Notes textbox increased to 6000 characters on the Contact's screen



Bug Resolved: Filtering by "Preferred Method of Contact" included phone numbers

• Filtering by "Preferred Method of Contact" no longer shows phone numbers

When users tried to filter by "Preferred Method of Contact" on a contact list view, there were two phone numbers that appeared as filter options. Those phone numbers were deleted from the list of options.

Bug Resolved: Text entered in the field "If other symptoms, please explain" did not change the Completion Status to "Completed"

 Text entered in the field "If other symptoms, please explain" will change the Completion Status to "Completed"

When text was entered in the "If other symptoms, please explain" textbox in the assessment, it left the Completion Status as "Attempted". This has been fixed; if text is entered, and you tab out of the textbox, the Completion Status will change to "Completed."
