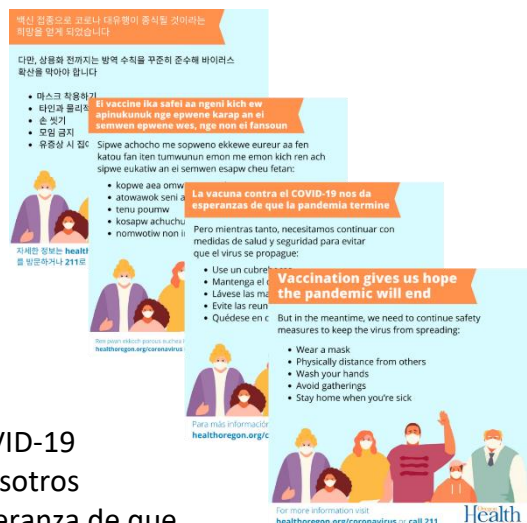

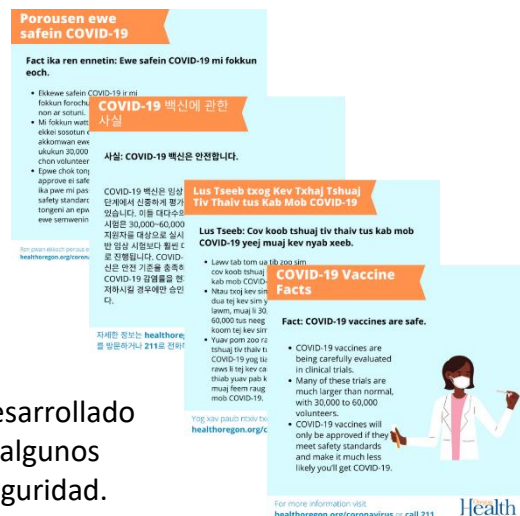

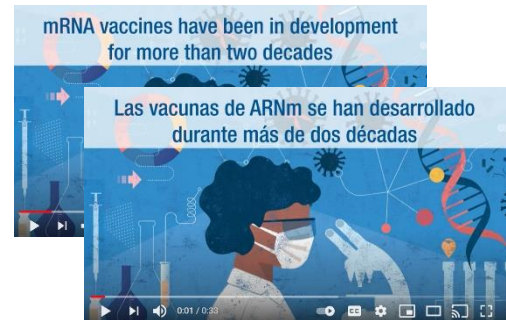

Any authorization for a vaccine will still be vetted for safety and effectiveness by three independent scientific groups, including:

- Data Safety Monitoring Board (DSMB),
- Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee (VRBPAC)
- Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP)
