Welcome to this how-to video for the Oregon Health Authority's My Electronic Vaccine Card web site. This video shows how to get your Electronic COVID-19 Vaccine Record. Oregon's Electronic COVID-19 Vaccine Record includes all the COVID-19 vaccinations in the state immunization registry.

How to register

1. Visit myelectronicvaccinecard.oregon.gov

Tota won na myelectronicvaccinecard.oregon.gov

2. Enter your first and last name and birth date

3. Enter either your mobile phone number or email address

Make sure the information you enter is the same as what you gave when you got vaccinated. Your name, birth date, and contact information will be used to find your vaccination record.

4. Create a personal identification number or PIN. Choose a PIN that you will remember and don't use four numbers in a row, or the same number four times

Fori ew PIN nampa. Fini ew PIN nampa kopwe chechemenieochu me kose tongeni kopwe aea ruwanu nampa epwe chok tetenino (awewe chok ren 1,2,3,4) ika kose tongeni kopwe aea ruwanu nampa epwe chok taitapuno (awewe chok ren 4,4,4,4).

5. Check the checkbox to confirm that the information you have provided is true.

6. Click Submit Button.

How to get your vaccination record

Ifa usun om kopwe angei rekortun om oppwos

You should get a link to your vaccination record within a few minutes of submitting your information either by phone or email.

Ina epwe toruk ew link ren om rekortun oppwosum kewe non chok fitu minich mwirin om ka wes me submit ekewe information ina epwe no ngeni noumwe nampan fon ika omwe email.

If you gave an email address, go to your email account and look for an email from Oregon Health Authority. If you don't see an email, look in your junk mail or spam folder. The email will have a link that says, "View Vaccine Record."

Ika pwe ke aea om email address, iwe kopwe no ngeni omwe email account ka kuta ew email seni ewe Oregon Health Authority. Ika pwe kese kuna me non om inbox, ka kuta non om kewe junk mail ika spam folder. Ewe email epwe send ngonuk epwe mak ew link won "View Vaccine Record."

If you gave a mobile phone number, you should get a text message with a link within a few minutes.

Ika pwe ke neuneu nampan noumwe fon, iwe ina kopwe kuna ew message ren na link epwe send ngonuk won noumwe fon non chok fitu minich.

Click on the link right away. It will expire after 24 hours.

When you click on the link, a new web page will open. Enter your PIN number and check the checkbox. Then click the button that says, "Validate PIN."

How to save your vaccination record

Ifa usun om kopwe savini ika anomwu rekortun om kopwe oppwos

This will take you to a web page with a list of your COVID-19 vaccinations and a QR code.

lei epwene uweikono won ew web page, fengen me tetenitiwen om kewe rekortun oppwosun COVID-19 me ew QR code.

A QR code is a black and white square that works like a barcode. Although it looks different from your CDC card, it contains all the same information as your CDC vaccination card. If someone needs to verify your vaccination information, they can scan your QR code with a phone or other device. This will allow them to check that your vaccination record is valid. However, your personal information will be protected by the system.

Ika ka save-ini om kewe rekort, iwe esapw tongeni epwe chiwen expire.

On the page with your QR code, go to the box that says Choose Here. You can select one of three choices:

Save to device

If you choose Save to Device, two buttons will appear. The first button allows you to download a PNG image, and the second allows you to download an accessible PDF.

Ika pwe ke fini kopwe save-ini won noumwe device, ruu buttons ina epwe pwata. Ewin button epwe mwut ngonuk om kopwe download PNG sassing, me ena ew button epwe mwut ngonuk om kopwe download accessible PDF.

If you use an iPhone, a button will appear allowing you to download your record to your Apple Wallet.

Ika pwe ke neuneu iPhone, ew button epwe pichita epwe mwut ngonuk om kopwe download om kewe rekort won omwe Apple Wallet.

If you use an Android Device, you can download your record to Google Pay.

Ika pwe ke neuneu Android device, ka tongeni downloadinatiw om kewe rekort ngeni ewe Google Pay.

You may need to update your phone's operating system to the latest version for these options to work.

Send via Email

If you choose Send via Email in the selector box, you can enter up to two email addresses and have your record emailed there.

Ika pwe ke fini an ewe tin ngeni via Email non ewe selector pwor, kemi tongeni wanong ruu sokkun email address epwe send ngeni.

Print

If you choose Print in the selector box, two buttons will appear. The first button allows you to download and a copy of your record.

Ika pwe ke fini Print non ewe selector pwor, ruu buttons epwe pichita. Ewin button epwe mwut ngonuk om kopwe download copy-in rekortun omwe oppwos.

The second button says "Don't Have Access to a Printer?" This button allows you to have a copy of your record mailed to you. Fill in your mailing address and click the button that says "Request Paper Copy." A printed copy of your record will be mailed to you within 2-3 weeks.

Ena oruwan button era "Don't Have Access to a Printer?" ei button epwe mwut ngonuk kopwe angei ew copy-in om kewe rekort sipwene chok mail ngonuk non mailbox. Amasowa ewe mailing address pwan tiki won na era "Request Paper Copy." Iwe a printed copy ren om kana rekort ina epwene mail ngonuk epwe torono ngeni 2 ngeni 3 weekan.

If you register and don't get a notice

If you don't get an email or text message within 24 hours, try again. If the information you entered does not match your vaccination record in Oregon's vaccination system, your record won't be found. Visit the Frequently Asked Questions webpage (<u>https://www.oregon.gov/oha/covid19/Pages/Digital-Vaccine-Record-FAQ.aspx</u>) for information on how to troubleshoot or contact 211 for support.

If you lose your record

lka a pout sonuk om rekort

Your vaccine record and QR code won't expire. Keep track of your record – however, if you lose it, you can always request another one. If you receive another vaccine after you save your digital vaccine record, you will need to request a new updated one.
