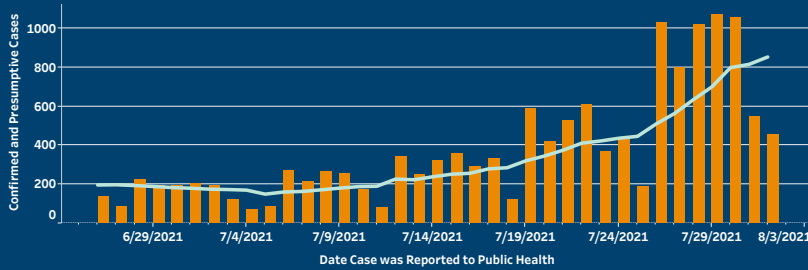

\*\*On May 31st the WHO released new names for the Variants using the Greek alphabet. OHA reports the CDC's identified Variants of Concern and Variants of Interest for the US which differ slightly from the WHO, and includes additional VOI, that will not have a WHO Greek alphabet label. The WHO reports the B.1.427 and B.1.429 variants together under the name "Epsilon". On June 19th, GISAID combined the two Epsilon variants in their data reports.

\* The Delta variant number includes P.1, AY.1, AY.2, and AY.3 pangolin lineages.

On July 20th, 2021 the CDC removed the P.1 (Zeta) variant as a Variant of Interest. OHA removed that data from the dashboard.

†The cumulative cases by county list does not include cases whose county of residence is unknown.

\*Every hospital in Oregon is asked to submit data twice daily to Oregon's Hospital Capacity Web System (HOSCAP). Data are based on the most recent report from the hospitals, available as of 9:00am. Hospital staff are asked to enter bed capacity information, by type, as well as the number of patients with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 illness who are currently hospitalized at the time of data entry. These data may conflict with hospitalization status in Orpheus due to case reporting and investigation lags and temporary discrepancies in case classification.

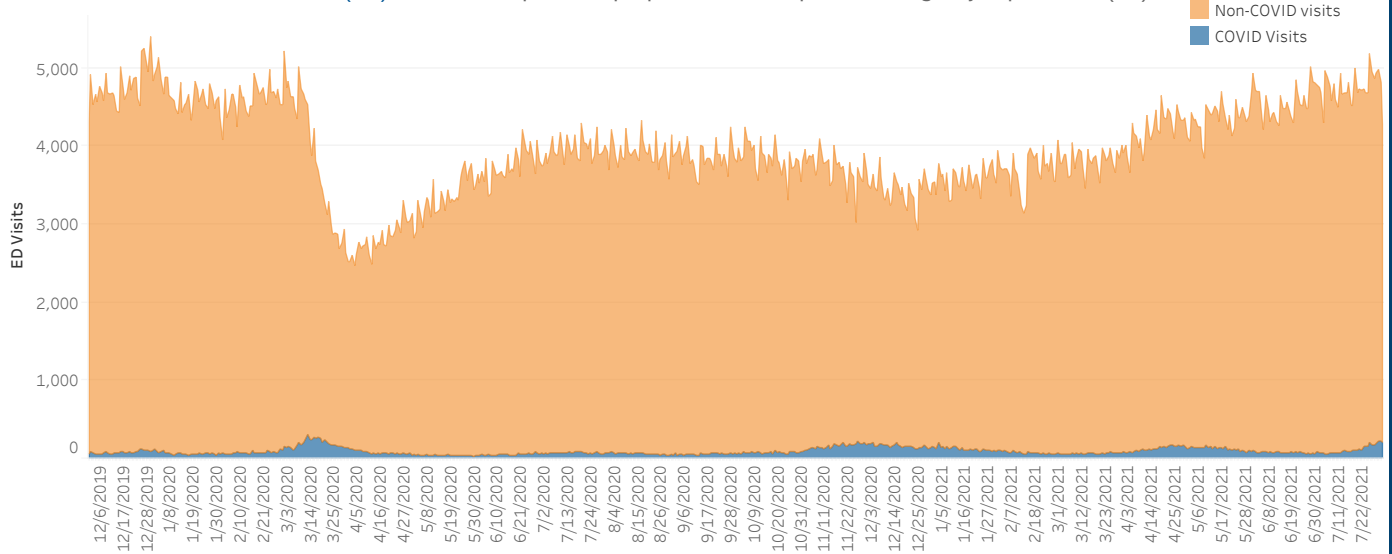
