New cases and deaths are reported from the previous day. The first business day following a weekend or holiday includes all newly reported data.

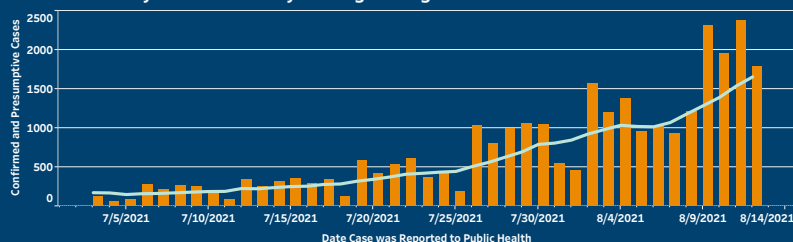

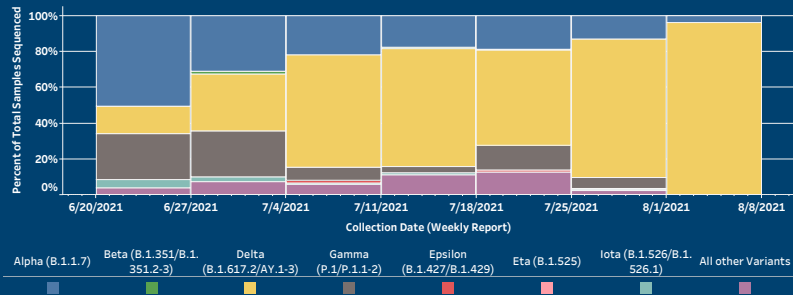
Daily Cases and 7 Day Moving Average over the Previous Six Weeks

**On May 31st the WHO released new names for the Variants using the Greek alphabet.

• The Delta variant number aggregates the B.1.517.2, AY.1, AY.2, and AY.3 pangolin lineages. The disaggregation of these lineages can be seen on the Variant Dashboard. There is a time-lag of approximately two weeks between when a sample is collected, sequenced and then reported by GISAID. This chart reflects that time-lag. On July 20th, 2021 the CDC removed the P.1 (Zeta) variant as a Variant of Interest. OHA removed that data from the dashboard.

*Every hospital in Oregon is asked to submit data twice daily to Oregon's Hospital Capacity Web System (HOSCAP). Data are based on the most recent report from the hospitals, available as of 9:00am. Hospital staff are asked to enter bed capacity information, by type, as well as the number of patients with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 illness who are currently hospitalized at the time of data entry. These data may conflict with hospitalization status in Orpheus due to case reporting and investigation lags and temporary discrepancies in case classification.

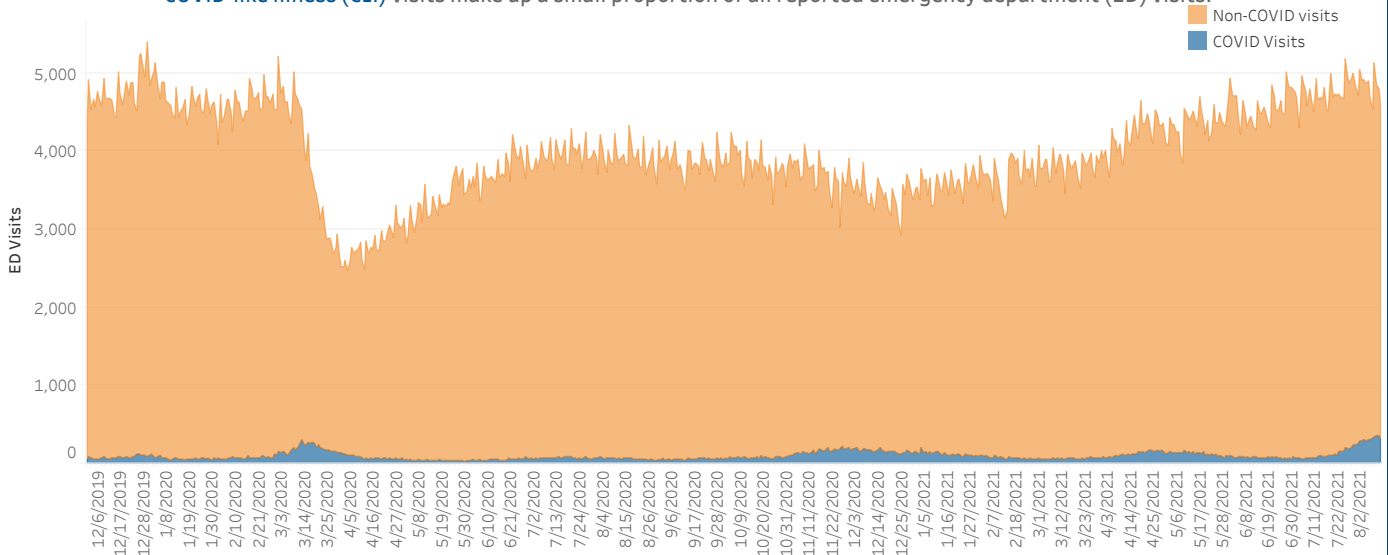
