List of educators now eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination

Updated on 1.25.2021

As of Monday, Jan. 25, educators—including public and private K-12 educators and staff, early childhood educators and staff, and licensed childcare centers and staff—can start getting vaccinated. Following is the current list, which may be updated as further policy guidance is released:

Early Childhood Educators and Staff, Child Care Providers and Staff

- All individuals in Emergency Child Care (ECC) facilities, including young adults (ages 16 to 18 years old)
- License-exempt caregivers providing the Oregon Department of Human Services subsidized child care in their own home or in the child's home
- Licensed and recorded non-ECC facilities (home-based or center-based)
- Office of Child Care (OCC) investigators
- Individuals in the substitute provider pool

Public and Private K-12 Educators and Staff

Public and private K-12 school system staff include (district paid and contracted) include:

- Teachers
- Substitute teachers
- Paraprofessionals
- Bus drivers
- Custodians – maintenance - facilities
- Nutrition staff
- School office staff
- School administrators
- Counselors and mental health support staff
- Health staff
- Childcare staff
- Library staff
- Other educators and school staff in the school
- Student and practicum teachers and their supervisors
- Early Intervention/Early Childhood Special Education staff
- Coaches and officials

- Extracurricular and program staff (including community partners who provide services to students and families on school campuses, as well as programs like outdoor school)
- District and education service district staff who spend time on school campuses (teacher coaches, TOSAs, IT, etc.)
