
# Oregon vaccinations: Current numbers

Number of people vaccinated (at least 1 dose): 1,994,968\* (49% of *total* population)


Number of people fully vaccinated (2 doses/J&J): 1,490,512 (36%)




## Vaccination rates by race and ethnicity






People vaccinated per 10,000: lighter colors represent counties with lower vaccination rates, while darker colors represent counties with higher vaccination rates.






