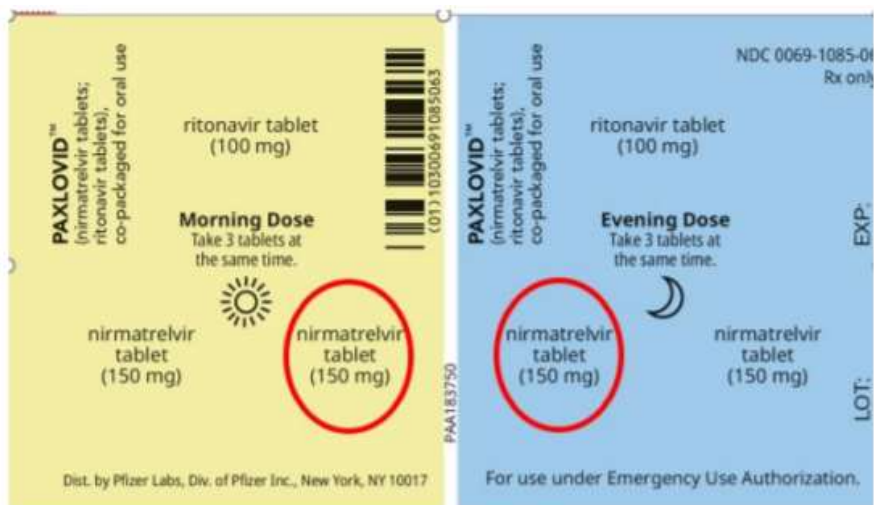




In patients with moderate renal impairment (eGFR ≥ 30 to < 60 mL/min), the dosage of PAXLOVID is 150 mg nirmatrelvir and 100 mg ritonavir twice daily for 5 days.

- In the event that the **PAXLOVID 150 mg;100 mg Dose Pack (“renal-Paxlovid”)** is **unavailable** the EUA directs pharmacists/dispensing providers to remove one AM tablet and one PM tablet of nirmatrelvir from each blister card and cover empty blisters with the provided manufacturer stickers.
- Prescriptions should specify the numeric dose of each active ingredient within.
- Providers should counsel patients about renal dosing instructions.
- Patients should be informed that their daily blister card has been intentionally altered to ensure they receive the correct dose.



The red ovals show where the nirmatrelvir tablets should be removed prior to dispensing Paxlovid to patients with moderate renal impairment.



A pre-printed sticker with dosing instructions (provided by the manufacturer) should be placed over the empty blisters where the nirmatrelvir tablets have been removed.
